**SUBJECT: Report on Special Revenue Fund Agreements for FY 2007**

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Section 174.02 as modified by the 1993 Legislature, the following report is being submitted to the Governor and the Committee on Finance of the Senate and the Committee on Ways and Means of the House of Representatives for their information.

Thirteen partnership agreements and one Light Rail Transit (LRT) agreements resulted in receipts totaling \$100,000 or more within FY 2007. A report is required to the Governor and Senate and House Committees of those partnerships, which are listed below:
