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APPENDIX B Nonlicensed Community Expert Statute Minnesota Statute 122A.25

122A.25 Nonlicensed community experts; variance.

Subdivision 1. **Authorization.** Notwithstanding any law or commissioner of education rule to the contrary, the Board of Teaching may allow school districts or charter schools to hire nonlicensed community experts to teach in the public schools or charter schools on a limited basis according to this section.

- Subd. 2. **Applications; criteria.** The school district or charter school shall apply to the Board of Teaching for approval to hire nonlicensed teaching personnel from the community. In approving or disapproving the application for each community expert, the board shall consider;
 - (1) the qualifications of the community person whom the district or charter school proposes to employ;
 - (2) the reasons for the need for a variance from the teacher licensure requirements;
 - (3) the districts' efforts to obtain licensed teachers, who are acceptable to the school board, for the particular course or subject area or the charter school's efforts to obtain licensed teachers for the particular course or subject area;
 - (4) the amount of teaching time for which the community expert would be hired;
 - (5) the extent to which the district or charter school is utilizing other nonlicensed community experts under this section;
 - (6) the nature of the community expert's proposed teaching responsibility; and
 - (7) the proposed level of compensation to the community expert.
 - Subd. 3. **Approval of plan.** The Board of Teaching shall approve or disapprove an application within 60 days of receiving it from a school district or charter school.
 - Subd. 4 **Background check.** A school district or charter school shall provide the Board of Teaching with confirmation that criminal background checks have been completed for all nonlicensed community experts employed by the district or charter school and approved by the Board of Teaching under this section.

8710.1400 PERSONNEL VARIANCES.

- Subpart 1. Authority to issue personnel variances. The Board of Teaching hereby authorizes the issuance of personnel variances whichpermit a teacher to teach in related subjects or fields for which suchteacher is not currently licensed. The designated administrator of alocal school district or charter school may request the Board of Teaching to issue a personnel variance which permits a teacher to teach subjects or fields for which that teacher is not currently licensed.
- Subp. 2. **Criteria for issuance.** A personnel variance authorizedby subpart 1 shall be issued to the designated administrator of aschool district or charter school if the following conditions are met:
- A. the designated administrator of the school district or charterschool requests a personnel variance according to this part;
- B. the designated administrator of the school district or charterschool verifies in writing that:
- (1) reasonable efforts have been made to assign existing staffto fill the position with a fully licensed teacher;
- (2) no applicant holding a teaching license in a subject orfield for which a personnel variance is requested can fulfill therequirements of the position; and
- (3) the position has been advertised, and if the position isone-half time or more, the position has been advertised statewide;
- C. the teacher for whom the request is made holds a current validMinnesota entrance, professional, or nonrenewable license granted bythe Board of Teaching; and
 - D. the teacher for whom the request is made is aware of theassignment.
- Subp. 2a. **Exceptions.** No personnel variances shall be grantedbased on holding a current valid Minnesota temporary limited licenseunless the temporary limited license was granted based on having metall requirements except part 8710.0500. No personnel variances shallbe granted for educational speech/language pathologists, schoolcounselors, school nurses, school psychologists, or school socialworkers.
- Subp. 3. **Duration of personnel variance.** An application for apersonnel variance must not be submitted prior to July 1 of the schoolyear for which it is requested. A personnel variance is valid for oneschool year or a portion of a school year from the date of state approval to the following June 30. If the requesting school districtor charter school offers summer school, the personnel variance that expires on June 30 is valid for teaching summer school in the year of expiration of the personnel variance.
- Subp. 3a. **Number of personnel variances allowed.** Beginning withpersonnel variances issued on or after October 16, 2000, no more thanthree personnel variances shall be granted for any teacher to teach insubjects or fields for which the teacher is not licensed.
- Subp. 4. Written conditions for granting or denying personnel variance. The Board of Teaching shall state in writing to the designated administrator of the school district or charter school the conditions for granting or denying the personnel variance requested pursuant to this part.

APPENDIX D Temporary Limited License Rule Minnesota Rule 8710.1250

Minnesota Rules, Table of Chapters

Table of contents for Chapter 8710

8710.1250 TEMPORARY LIMITED LICENSES.

- Subpart 1. Authority to issue temporary limited licenses. The Board of Teaching authorizes the issuance of temporary limited licensesthat permit a person to teach in an area for which the person has notcompleted an approved preparation program that leads to licensure bythe Board of Teaching.
- Subp. 2. **Criteria for issuance.** The Board of Teaching shall granta temporary limited license authorized by subpart 1 to an applicant if it finds that the following conditions are met:
- A. the designated administrator of the employing school districtor charter school requests a temporary limited license according to his part;
- B. the designated administrator of the employing school districtor charter school verifies in writing that:
- (1) no applicant holding a license in a subject or field forwhich a temporary limited license is requested can fulfill therequirements of the position;
- (2) the position has been advertised, and if the position isone-half time or more, the position has been advertised statewide;
- (3) the school district or charter school will provide a mentorto give support and assistance in necessary skill development for theperson holding a temporary limited license;
- (4) the applicant for whom the temporary limited license isrequested holds a baccalaureate degree from a college or universityaccredited by the regional association for the accreditation ofcolleges and secondary schools; and
- (5) the applicant has completed a college or university degreewith at least a minor in the area for which teacher licensure is requested, or a degree directly related to the professional preparation for which educational speech/language pathology, school nurse, schoolpsychologist, school social worker, or school counselor licensure is requested. An applicant for a temporary limited license as a school nurse must also provide evidence of current registration to practice as a licensed registered nurse and current registration as a public healthnurse under the Board of

Nursing. An applicant for a temporary limited license as a schoolsocial worker must also provide evidence of current licensure topractice as a social worker under the Board of Social Work.

- Subp. 2a. Exception for temporary limited licenses for career and technical fields. Limited licenses shall be issued for teaching careerand technical fields under parts 8710.8010 to 8710.8080 to applicants who do not meet the criteria defined in subpart 2, item B, subitem (4), if the employing school district verifies that the individual hascompleted specific training for and at least four years of full-time employment or the equivalent in an occupation of the employment field to be taught. Renewal of temporary limited licenses issued under this subpart must require evidence of the applicant's having completed eights emester credits toward full licensure within the previous year. All other provisions of this part apply.
- Subp. 3. Validity and duration of temporary limited licenses. An application for a temporary limited license must not be submitted prior to August 1 of the school year for which it is requested. A temporarylimited license is issued for one school year or a portion of a schoolyear from the date of issuance to the following June 30 and is validfor use in the requesting school district or charter school only. If the requesting school district or charter school offers summer school, a temporary limited license that expires on June 30 is valid forteaching summer school in the year of expiration of the license.

- Subp. 4. Number of temporary limited licenses allowed. Beginningwith temporary limited licenses issued on or after October 16, 2000, nomore than three temporary limited licenses shall be granted to anapplicant under subpart 2 and no more than five temporary limitedlicenses shall be granted to an applicant under subpart 2a.
- Subp. 5. Exception for applicants prepared in Minnesota teacher preparation institutions. A graduate of a Minnesota teacherpreparation institution who has been granted a temporary limitedlicense under subpart 2 but has not successfully completed the skillsarea examination may renew the temporary limited license two times. To renew a temporary limited license an applicant must:
- A. provide an official score report which verifies having takenthe examination during the period of each temporary limited license; and
- B. provide evidence of participating in an approved remedialassistance program provided by a school district or postsecondaryinstitution that includes a formal diagnostic component in the specificareas in which the applicant did not obtain qualifying scores duringthe period of each temporary limited license.
- Subp. 6. Exception for applicants prepared outside Minnesota. An applicant who has completed a licensure program outside Minnesota maybe granted a temporary limited license under part 8710.0400.

APPENDIX E Waiver Statute Minnesota Statute 122A.09 subd 10

Minnesota Statutes 2004, Table of Chapters

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122A.09 Duties.

Subdivision 1. Code of ethics. The Board of Teaching mustdevelop by rule a code of ethics covering standards of professionalteaching practices, including areas of ethical conduct and professional performance and methods of enforcement.

- Subd. 2. Advise members of profession. The board must act in an advisory capacity to members of the profession in matters of interpretation of the code of ethics.
- Subd. 3. **Election of chair and officers.** The board shall elect a chair and such other officers as it may deem necessary.
- Subd. 4. License and rules. (a) The board must adopt rules tolicense public school teachers and interns subject to chapter 14.
- (b) The board must adopt rules requiring a person to successfullycomplete a skills examination in reading, writing, and mathematics as arequirement for initial teacher licensure. Such rules must requirecollege and universities offering a board-approved teacher preparationprogram to provide remedial assistance to persons who did not achieve aqualifying score on the skills examination, including those for whomEnglish is a second language.
- (c) The board must adopt rules to approve teacher preparationprograms. The board, upon the request of a postsecondary studentpreparing for teacher licensure or a licensed graduate of a teacherpreparation program, shall assist in resolving a dispute between theperson and a postsecondary institution providing a teacher preparationprogram when the dispute involves an institution's recommendation forlicensure affecting the person or the person's credentials. At the board's discretion, assistance may include the application of chapter

14.

- (d) The board must provide the leadership and shall adopt rules forthe redesign of teacher education programs to implement a researchbased, results-oriented curriculum that focuses on the skills teachersneed in order to be effective. The board shall implement new systems ofteacher preparation program evaluation to assure program effectivenessbased on proficiency of graduates in demonstrating attainment ofprogram outcomes.
- (e) The board must adopt rules requiring successful completion of an examination of general pedagogical knowledge and examinations oflicensure-specific teaching skills. The rules shall be effective on the dates determined by the board but not later than September 1, 2001.
- (f) The board must adopt rules requiring teacher educators to workdirectly with elementary or secondary school teachers in elementary or
- secondary schools to obtain periodic exposure to the elementary orsecondary teaching environment.
- (g) The board must grant licenses to interns and to candidates forinitial licenses.
- (h) The board must design and implement an assessment system whichrequires a candidate for an initial license and first continuinglicense to demonstrate the abilities necessary to perform selected, representative teaching tasks at appropriate levels.
- (i) The board must receive recommendations from local committees as established by the board for the renewal of teaching licenses.
- (j) The board must grant life licenses to those who qualifyaccording to requirements established by the board, and suspend orrevoke licenses pursuant to sections 122A.20 and 214.10. The board must not establish any expiration date for

application for lifelicenses.

- (k) The board must adopt rules that require all licensed teacherswho are renewing their continuing license to include in their renewalrequirements further preparation in the areas of using positivebehavior interventions and in accommodating, modifying, and adapting curricula, materials, and strategies to appropriately meet the needs of individual students and ensure adequate progress toward the state's graduation rule.
- (1) In adopting rules to license public school teachers who providehealth-related services for disabled children, the board shall adoptrules consistent with license or registration requirements of the commissioner of health and the health-related boards who license personnel who perform similar services outside of the school.
- (m) The board must adopt rules that require all licensed teacherswho are renewing their continuing license to include in their renewalrequirements further reading preparation, consistent with section122A.06, subdivision 4. The rules do not take effect until they areapproved by law. Teachers who do not provide direct instructionincluding, at least, counselors, school psychologists, school nurses, school social workers, audiovisual directors and coordinators, andrecreation personnel are exempt from this section.
- (n) The board must adopt rules that require all licensed teacherswho are renewing their continuing license to include in their renewalrequirements further preparation in understanding the key warning signsof early-onset mental illness in children and adolescents.
- Subd. 5. Commissioner's representative to comment on proposedrule. Prior to the adoption by the Board of Teaching of any rule whichmust be submitted to public hearing, a representative of the commissioner shall appear before the Board of Teaching and at the hearing required pursuant to section 14.14, subdivision 1, to comment on the cost and educational implications of that proposed rule.
- Subd. 6. Register of persons licensed. The executive secretaryof the Board of Teaching shall keep a record of the proceedings of anda register of all persons licensed pursuant to the provisions of thischapter. The register must show the name, address, license number andthe renewal of the license. The board must on July 1, of each year oras soon thereafter as is practicable, compile a list of such dulylicensed teachers and transmit a copy of the list to the board. A copyof the register must be available during business hours at the officeof the board to any interested person.
- Subd. 7. Commissioner's assistance; board money. The commissioner shall provide all necessary materials and assistance forthe transaction of the business of the Board of Teaching and all moneysreceived by the Board of Teaching shall be paid into the state treasuryas provided by law. The expenses of administering sections 122A.01, 122A.05 to 122A.09, 122A.15, 122A.16, 122A.17, 122A.18, 122A.20,122A.21, 122A.22, 122A.23, 122A.26, 122A.30, 122A.32, 122A.40, 122A.41,122A.42, 122A.45, 122A.49, 122A.52, 122A.53, 122A.54, 122A.55, 122A.56,122A.57, and 122A.58 which are incurred by the Board of Teaching shallbe paid for from appropriations made to the Board of Teaching.
- Subd. 8. Fraud; gross misdemeanor. A person who claims to be alicensed teacher without a valid existing license issued by the boardor any person who employs fraud or deception in applying for orsecuring a license is guilty of a gross misdemeanor.
- Subd. 9. Board may adopt rules. The Board of Teaching may adoptrules subject to the provisions of chapter 14 to implement sections $\underline{122A.05}$ to $\underline{122A.09}$, $\underline{122A.16}$, $\underline{122A.18}$, $\underline{122A.20}$, $\underline{122A.21}$, and $\underline{122A.23}$.
- Subd. 10. **Variances.** (a) Notwithstanding subdivision 9 and section 14.05, subdivision 4, the Board of Teaching may grant avariance to its rules upon application by a school district forpurposes of implementing experimental programs in learning ormanagement.
- (b) To enable a school district to meet the needs of students enrolled in an alternative education program and to enable licensedteachers instructing those students to satisfy content area licensurerequirements, the Board of Teaching

annually may permit a licensedteacher teaching in an alternative education program to instructstudents in a content area for which the teacher is not licensed, consistent with paragraph (a).

APPENDIX F Non Renewable License Rule Minnesota Rule 8710.1410

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8710.1410 NONRENEWABLE LICENSE.

- Subpart 1. Authority to issue nonrenewable license. The Board of Teaching may issue a nonrenewable license that permits a licensed teacher to teach in a subject or field for which the teacher is not currently licensed. The designated administrator of a local school district or charter school may request the board to issue the teacher's nonrenewable license.
- Subp. 2. Criteria for issuance. A nonrenewable license under subpart 1 shall be issued to the school district or charter school when the following conditions are met:
- A. the designated administrator of the school district or charter school requests a nonrenewable license under this part;
- B. the designated administrator of the school district or charter school in the application verifies in writing that:
- (1) reasonable efforts have been made to assign existing staff to fill the position with a fully licensed teacher;
- (2) no applicant holding a teaching license in the subject or field for which a nonrenewable license is requested can fulfill the requirements of the position;
- (3) the position has been advertised, and if the position is one-half time or more, the position has been advertised statewide;
- (4) the administrator on behalf of the licensed teacher will use the "High Objective Uniform State Standard of Evaluation" (HOUSSE) and those criteria as necessary and proper to demonstrate subject matter competence in the nonlicensed area as established by the Board of Teaching in collaboration with the Department of Education, and that the teacher meets the board's criteria;
- (5) the district will provide for a high quality professional development plan for the teacher that is sustained and classroom-focused before and while teaching; and will provide ongoing support for the teacher or a teacher mentoring program; and
- (6) the teacher is in an approved course of study and will complete the approved program by the end of the third school year;
- C. the teacher for whom the request is made holds a current valid Minnesota entrance or professional license granted by the Board of Teaching; and
- D. the teacher for whom the request is made understands the criteria of the assignment and is in an approved course of study or there is evidence to demonstrate the teacher is making application for an approved course of study.
- Subp. 3. **Exceptions.** A nonrenewable license shall not be granted to a teacher holding a temporary limited license. A nonrenewable license shall not be granted to speech/language pathologists, school counselors, school nurses, school psychologists, or school social workers.

- Subp. 4. **Duration of nonrenewable license.** An application for a nonrenewable license must not be submitted before the July 1 preceding the first school year for which it is requested. A nonrenewable license is valid for three school years from the date of state approval to the end of the third school year, June 30. If the requesting school district or charter school offers summer school, the nonrenewable license that expires on June 30 is valid for teaching summer school in the year of expiration of the nonrenewable license.
- Subp. 5. Written conditions for granting or denying a nonrenewable license. The Board of Teaching shall state in writing to the designated administrator of the school district or charter school the conditions for granting or denying the nonrenewable license requested under this part.
- Subp. 6. Approval for professional license. The board will issue a professional license to a teacher who has successfully completed all requirements under the board's jurisdiction as defined in Minnesota Statutes, section 122A.18.
