NOTICE TO BIDDERS, WAGE DETERMINATIONS

The wage determinations include classifications which the Commissioner of the Department of Labor and Industry has determined to be the classes of labor and mechanics commonly employed in highway construction work. Additional classifications may develop between certifications by the Commissioner. Therefore, no inference may be drawn from the omission of classifications which have local usage. Further, the State will not be liable for increased labor costs if and when additional classifications are subsequently required or wage rates increase prior to the awarding of contracts.

PREVAILING HOURS OF LABOR

The "prevailing hours of labor" for all classes of laborers and mechanics to be employed on State contract highway construction work are eight hours per day and forty hours per calendar week.
