SUBJECT: Prevailing Wage Schedules

The Prevailing Wage Division, Department of Labor and Industry, is no longer issuing prevailing wage rate schedules for the entire state at one time. We have divided the state into three zones in an effort to conduct more thorough surveys.

The enclosed map indicates the survey dates and the dates that new prevailing wage schedules take effect in each zone. Your agency will receive prevailing wage schedules soon after the "effect" date for the counties within the zone being certified. Please retain these schedules until new schedules are sent to your agency by the Prevailing Wage Division. At that time, replace the old schedules with the new schedules.

Updating your files in this manner will insure that current wage schedules can be included within your construction contracts as specified by Minnesota Statute 177.43, subd. 3.
