SUBJECT: **PREVAILING WAGE CERTIFICATIONS**

Effective December 1, 1985 pursuant to Laws of Minnesota, Statutes 177.41 to 177.44, the Department of Labor and Industry has certified prevailing wage rates for commercial construction in the following Minnesota counties: Anoka, Benton, Big Stone, Carver, Chippewa, Chisago, Dakota, Douglas, Grant, Hennepin, Isanti, Kanabec, Kandiyohi, McLeod, Meeker, Mille Lacs, Morrison, Pine, Pope, Ramsey, Scott, Sherburne, Stearns, Stevens, Swift, Todd, Traverse, Washington and Wright.

**NOTE: MINNESOTA STATUTE 177.43, subd. 3 required that the contract must specifically state the prevailing wage rates, prevailing hours of labor, and hourly basic rate of pay.**
