SUBJECT: PREVAILING WAGE CERTIFICATIONS

Effective February 1, 1986 pursuant to Laws of Minnesota, Statutes 177.41 to 177.44, the Department of Labor and Industry will certify prevailing wage rates for highway/ heavy construction in the following Minnesota counties: Aitkin, Becker, Beltrami, Carlton, Cass, Clay, Clearwater, Cook, Crow Wing, Hubbard, Itasca, Kittson, Koochiching, Lake, Lake of the Woods, Mahnomen, Marshall, Norman, Ottertail, Pennington, Polk, Red Lake, Roseau, St. Louis, Wadena and Wilkin.
