SUBJECT: PREVAILING WAGE CERTIFICATIONS

Effective August 1, 1986 pursuant to Laws of Minnesota, Statutes 177.41 to 177.44, the Department of Labor and Industry will certify prevailing wage rates for commercial construction in the following Minnesota counties: Aitkin, Becker, Beltrami, Carlton, Cass, Clay, Clearwater, Cook, Crow Wing, Hubbard, Itasca, Kittson, Koochiching, Lake, Lake of the Woods, Mahnomen, Marshall, Norman, Ottertail, Pennington, Polk, Red Lake, Roseau, St. Louis, Wadena and Wilkin.

NOTE: Minnesota Statutes 177.43, subd. 3 requires that the contract must specifically state the prevailing wage rates, prevailing hours of labor, and hourly basic rate of pay.
