Minnesota Medical Assistance (MA, Title XIX)

Nursing Facility Recipient Rates

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Statewide and by County 1980 - 2004

Introduction

This bulletin provides recipient rates for Title XIX (Medical Assistance / MA) nursing facilities (NFs) by county and by specific age groups for 1980, 1985, 1990, 1995, 2000, and 2004. Prior to 1990, the NF group included SNF, ICF-I and ICF-II facilities.

The recipient rates are standardized by dividing each region's (county's) count of NF residents who were recipients of Medical Assistance by the age-group population estimate for the county for that year and then multiplying it by 1,000. (This gives the standard rate per 1,000 and is the same as using the population divided by 1,000 as the divisor in calculating the rate.) The resident counts were derived from the Medicaid Eligibility Files prior to 1995 and from the Medicaid Payment Files for 1995 and later. For years after 2000, the Medicaid Payment Files were queried via the Human Services Department's Data Warehouse. The population numbers were derived from an old and a new set of population projections prepared by the State Demographer's Office.

Prior to 1995, all NF residents were identified on the Case Information File according to their county of financial responsibility in January of each year reflected in this report. This was a point in time reference. For 1995 and later, NF residents were counted if MA paid at least one NF claim for January services within six months. Most claims for January are paid in February, but we also looked for late claims for January service processed in the following six months.

This new edition of the recipiency rates provides tables of utilization for four age cohorts: 0-64 years old, 65-84 years old, 85 years old and up, and for All-Ages.

A summary of the statewide recipient rates for 1980, 1985, 1990 and 1995 through 2004, for the age cohorts identified in this report, follows below. Rates for January 2000 in this edition are recomputed, using the original NF recipient counts but dividing by the actual population figures from the 2000 Census rather than by population estimates for that year which earlier editions used.
