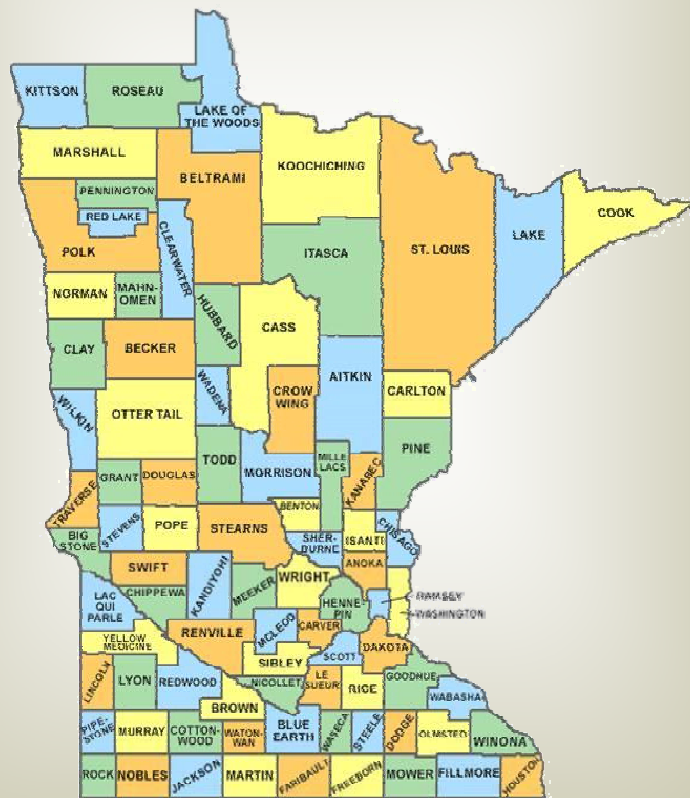

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# Introduction

## Where State Residents Received Hospital Acute Care in 2006

Patient origin studies are a useful way to describe where community hospital capacity is geographically located within the state, which populations are using it, and for what types of services. This information can be useful to policy makers in deciding whether the state as a whole, or specific areas within it, has the health care resources to meet future needs. This report provides a description of the geographic patterns of community acute care hospital<sup>1</sup> use in Minnesota in 2006. It is an update to a previous report using 2000 data.

A unique feature of this update is that it shows the inflow of patients from other states to Minnesota hospitals, as well as the outflow of Minnesota residents to hospitals in North Dakota, South Dakota, and Iowa.<sup>2</sup> The data analyzed for the report include 129 out of 133 community acute care hospitals in the state.

The report includes three summary tables, followed by detailed tables for each of Minnesota's 87 counties. Table 1 summarizes the patterns of travel for inpatient hospital services by county. Table 2 summarizes the geographic origin of patients cared for by the hospitals in each county. Finally, Table 3 shows U.S. Census Bureau estimates of county population size and age distribution as of July 1, 2006.

Some key general findings from this analysis include:

- During 2006, 59% of Minnesota residents hospitalized for acute care received it at hospitals within their home county, while 37% were hospitalized in other counties, and 4% in received care in other states.

- Residents of Olmsted County and St. Louis County were the most likely to receive hospital care within their own counties (97% and 94% respectively) while residents of Le Sueur and Nicollet Counties were most likely to travel outside their own county for hospital care (97% and 89% respectively).<sup>3</sup>
- In 2006, slightly less than 4% of Minnesota resident hospitalizations were in other states, predominantly in North Dakota and South Dakota.<sup>4</sup> Minnesota residents using hospitals in other states were most likely to live on the western side of the state.
- Out-of-state patients traveling into Minnesota for hospital care were mostly residents of Wisconsin (56%), Iowa (18%), North Dakota (9%), and South Dakota (5%).<sup>5</sup>

Summary Tables 1, 2, and 3 appear following this introductory section. A page for each county provides details on where county residents received care, and the geographic distribution of patients hospitalized in each county by major service category

Appendix A describes the data collection process used for this analysis and the definitions employed. Appendix B lists the hospitals participating in the analysis by county. As required by Minnesota Statutes Section 62J.321 subdivision 5, hospitals were provided an opportunity to review their included data and comment on the report. MDH received no comments from hospitals.

# Appendix A

## Data Collection and Service Definitions

### Data Collection

Data for this report were summarized from the Minnesota Department of Health 2006 Hospital Discharge Data Set. Out of 133 hospitals operating in the state, 129 participated in the 2006 discharge data collection. A list of participating and non-participating hospitals appears in Appendix B by county. Seven counties currently have no local community hospital.

Admission-through-discharge claims were included in this analysis. Late charges, interim claims, duplicates, and claims for normal newborns were excluded. Using diagnosis and procedure code information appearing on each record, all discharge claims were classified into one of the following broad acute care service categories: Medical/Surgical, Obstetrics, Pediatrics, or Behavioral.

### Service Definitions

*Services Provided* – The broad categories of hospital services used in this report were created from hospital specialty service codes provided by the Minnesota Hospital Association (MHA). MHA defines its service categories as aggregations of Diagnosis Related Groups (DRGs) reflecting the patient's principal diagnosis, principal procedure, age, gender, and discharge status on each claim. MDH further aggregated the MHA service categories for use in this report as follows:

- Med/Surg – Medicine/Surgery refers to hospital services provided as general medicine, general surgery, oncology, cardiology, ophthalmology, otorhinolaryngology, neurology, orthopedics, urology, gynecology, and rehabilitation for patients 15 years of age and older.
- Obstetrics refers to services related to pregnancy, childbirth and the puerperium.
- Behavioral – Refers to mental diseases and disorders, substance abuse, and/or chemical dependency diagnoses.
- Pediatrics – Premature, low birthweight, or sick newborns, and children less than 15 years of age regardless of diagnosis.

### Confidentiality Considerations

If any table cell throughout the report had fewer than ten cases, it was left blank.
