- Specific projects being carried out by private contractors, including their employment impact.







## Did the website show...

- Distributions of spending among the state's counties (or other geography);










## Did the website show...

- Contract details, including dollar amounts, the name of the contractor and the text of the contract;



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## Did the website show...

- Data on the jobs created or retained by the project; and
- The status of the project (portion completed and expected duration).




- Show the amount of ARRA money allocated by program category
- Lists some agency data on the website






### Some Improvements

- 3. Map all the projects that receive funding.

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4. List all the contractors receiving money, include the amount received, and the contract or RFP text.





#### Recommendations


- Show the projected or actual jobs data for each individual project that is funded including wage data.

- 9. Conduct annual audits to fact-check.






























#### **Update & Correct Data**

- Government has an obligation to check the data for inaccuracies by auditing it.











#### Why Transparency?

- States already have technical capacity; a GIS company distributed free templates to all levels of government which many states followed
