# Section 2. Short-term Offender Profile as of 01-01-2009

**Definition**: Short-term offenders are those offenders, for whom <u>in a felony sentence to</u> imprisonment, when the remaining term of imprisonment is for 180 days or less, committed to the custody of the commissioner of corrections and are designated to serve the remaining term of imprisonment at a workhouse, work farm, county jail or other place <u>authorized by law</u> (Minnesota Statutes § 609.105, Subdivision 1). This became effective July 1, 2003.

Note: The short-term offender population number (312) indicated below is excluded from all statistics reported in Section 1 of the Adult Inmate Profile.
