Re: Office of the Governor Personnel Costs Supported by Agency Appropriations

Laws of 1995, Chapter 254, Article 1, Section 3, requires that the Commissioner of Finance shall report to the chairs of the Government Finance Division of the Senate and the Finance Division of the House of Representatives any personnel costs incurred by the Office of the Governor and the Lieutenant Governor that were supported by appropriations to other agencies during the previous fiscal year.

No general fund money was used by other state agencies to support FY 1995 personnel costs incurred by the Governor's Office.

The Department of Administration is continuing its responsibility for the costs of Plant Management duties at the Governor's residence. An Administrative Order provides reimbursement of salary costs for a groundskeeper/general maintenance position. Those costs total \$33,388.80 for FY 1995.

In addition, the Governor's Office had an interagency agreement transferring a staff member to the Metropolitan Waste Control Commission to perform work on the Commission's behalf. That agreement ended August 15, 1994.
