Re: Office of the Governor Personnel Costs Supported by Agency Appropriations

Laws of 1992, Chapter 513, Article 4, Section 7, requires that the Commissioner of Finance shall report to the chairs of the Finance State Government Division of the Senate Finance Committee and the State Government Finance Division of House Governmental Operations and Gaming Committee those personnel costs incurred by the Office of the Governor and Lieutenant Governor that were supported by appropriations of other agencies during the previous fiscal year. Costs by agency are as follows:

The Department of Administration is continuing historical responsibility for plant management duties at the residence through an interagency agreement delegating supervisory responsibility to the residence manager.

The Pollution Control Agency paid part of the one time costs associated with transfer of a clerical employee to the Governor's office.

In addition, the Governor's Office has executed an inter-agency agreement transferring a staff member to the Metropolitan Waste Control Commission to perform work on the Commission's behalf.
