Dear Senator Cohen and Representative Solberg:

The purpose of this letter is to notify you of the proposed budget forms and process pursuant to M.S. 16A.10 for the upcoming FY 2012-2013 biennial budget.

Minnesota Management and Budget (MMB) will be using the Budget Information System (BIS) to collect, update, review and publish information pertaining to the FY 2012-2013 biennial budget. The overall budget structure and fiscal pages will remain consistent with the FY 2010-2011 biennial budget, although there may be some changes to narrative templates and individual agencies' budget structures. This is the last time the BIS will be used for biennial budget development so system changes are not expected, rather MMB is focusing its efforts on improving narrative and background information as well as the instructions provided to agencies.

During a transition year to a new administration, legislation provides additional time to develop and publish the biennial budget, however, we are working diligently to have agencies complete as much work as possible on background narrative materials and base budgets over the summer. This year we will again be using the format of providing biennial budget instructions in three parts: 1) Part A, Preparation of Background Materials; 2) Part B, Preparing Fiscal Information in the Biennial Budget System; and 3) Part C, Governor's Budget Recommendations. Below is a tentative timeline by which MMB will provide instructions and training to agencies.
