## II. PROJECT SUMMARY AND RESULTS:

This project includes the major rehabilitation and development of state park and recreation area buildings, structures and utility systems and the rehabilitation and betterment of non-building facilities such as trails, roads, campgrounds and resources. Results of the 1998 appropriation will include the acquisition of private lands within the statutory boundaries of state parks as listed in column 1 of the attached chart.
