VI. CONTEXT

- A. Significance: These projects/Result Areas will eliminate further deterioration of identified physical structures and utility systems and subsequently extend their life expectancies. In the case of the projects associated with the zoo they will improve the safety and management of the animal collection as required in the standards of the Federal government, as defined within the Animal Welfare Act, and assist in meeting and sustaining the standards for continued accreditation of Saint Paul's Como Zoo with the American Zoo and Aquarium Association. In the case of the projects associated with the conservatory they will improve and sustain the environments necessary for state-of-the-art plant propagation, growth and display.
- **B.** Time: Projects/Result Areas 1 and 3-8 are completed. Project/Result Area 2 is intended for completion by the June 30, 2002 deadline.

C. Budget Context:

1. The City of Saint Paul's identified capital maintenance needs on the Como Campus are in excess of \$1.8 million. The City recognizes the importance of maintaining its physical structures and utility systems and has appropriated capital maintenance funds from 1996 through 2002 for the following projects:

Result 4: Re-Line Condensate/Vacuum Tank for Heating System

Result 5: Replace Heating System Tubes in Boiler #3

Result 6: Replace Heating System Tubes in Boilers #1 and #2

Result 7: Repair and Resurface Zoo Pathway System

- Result 8: Replace Polycarbonate on Conservatory Growing Range, Dormant House, and Bonsai Room
- 2. Construction Continues on: Result 2: Replace Fiberglass Reinforced Concrete Facade on Front of Conservatory. The City and the St. Paul Foundation have combined to add \$670,000.00 to this work so that the entire facade can be replaced under one contract. The LMCR funded portion of this work has been completed with the entire project to be completed in the fall of 2002.
