The Loss Assessment Reports (LAR) indicates that affected apple and grape growers experienced crop losses of 30 percent or more due to frost damage in Chippewa, Renville and Wright counties, and tornados, hail storms, heavy rains and flooding in Freeborn County.

The Governor's letter requests that affected farmers be made eligible for the U.S. Department of Agriculture's low-interest Emergency Loan program administered by the Farm Service Agency.
