SUBJECT:	Semi-Annual Appointment Report for 7-1-2010 through 12-31-2010

The semi-annual Appointment Report, required under Minnesota Statutes 43A.04, Subd. 7, is attached. The total number of appointments is a count of specific transactions tied to various appointment categories as indicated on the attached page. One person may have several different types of appointments throughout the reporting period and so the report does not reflect the actual number of new employees hired.

Overall hiring activity decreased during this period as compared to the first half of 2010. The following is a snapshot of the overall hiring activity for the last three years.

The information on the attached report shows activity that has occurred in several different appointment categories. As the above chart indicates, hiring numbers were up for this reporting period as compared to the same period a year ago. Hiring numbers have decreased, however, from the first half of 2010. A pattern is emerging over the last 2 calendar years where higher numbers of appointments are occurring in the first half of each year compared to the second half. It is assumed that this is attributable to agency needs for seasonal or other temporary summer hires.

Two changes are worth noting for this reporting period. There is an overall reduction of 139 temporary appointments and an increase of 66 trainees to probationary appointments when compared to the first half of 2010. Most trainee to probationary conversions occur at the Department of Corrections in the classification of Corrections Officer.

Overall hiring continued to show lower numbers than the period before hiring restrictions were in place when 4855 hires took place from July – December, 2008.
