Dear Mr. LaFleur:

I am writing to explain that the reporting requirements of M.S. 103G.705, Subdivision 1 are superfluous, due to action of the 2010 legislature in repealing M.S. 103G.705, Subdivision 2. Subdivision 2 set up the financing mechanism for the program, and by repealing that part, there is no way to implement the program authorized in Subdivision 1.

Also, since this law was first passed in 1999, there has only been one loan applied for or approved under this Statute. That loan is scheduled to be paid back in 2013, and the proceeds now go to the General Fund in accordance with another law passed last year.

I will suggest to our legislative liaison, that the DNR ask the legislature to repeal the remaining part of 103G.705 to avoid future confusion.
