Dairy Development and Profitability Enhancement Program Work Plan FY2012

Dairy Profit Teams

The dairy profit teams provide one-on-one guidance to dairy producers across the state, providing comprehensive financial analysis, risk management education as well as production enhancement advice.

In FY12: <u>Support and direct the Dairy Profit Teams in working with at least 250 farms statewide</u>. Continue to stress utilization of 72% of the budget towards team activities.

Dairy Business Planning Grants

The business planning grants provide matching dollars for producers to develop a business plan. The grant will be capped at \$3,000 per producer. There has been significant increase in requests for these funds. More applicants seek funds for completion of business plans and for stray voltage testing.

In FY12: Work with 47 farms statewide, with cap at \$3000 per application. Grant recipients required to provide a one to one match.

Administration

The administration for this program is 1 FTE at MDA and includes office rental, benefits package, copier expenses and supplies.
