Dear Agency Heads,

Minnesota's SmartFleet Committee is happy to report that agencies are continuing to increase their use of E85 fuel in state vehicles. During the first two quarters of calendar year 2011 agencies used 477,322 gallons of E85 fuel. This is up from 437,063 gallons during the same time period in 2010. *Over one million gallons of E85 fuel have been used in the last 12 month period.*

Attached is the fleet retail fuel report for the first two quarters of calendar year 2011. This report shows that state agencies together are using 18.5 percent E85 fuel and 81.5 percent petroleum-based gasoline in state vehicles. The report provides a summary of the fleet fuel purchases, by agency, through the Voyager fuel cards. Please share this report with the operating divisions of your agency. *Please direct vehicle operators to use E85 whenever it is available.*

Executive Order 11-13 calls for Minnesota state government to reduce the quantity of petroleum fuels consumed in transportation. Gasoline quantity is to be reduced 50 percent by 2015, from a base established in 2005. Using E85 fuel instead of gasoline will help move the state toward accomplishing this goal.

While we are making progress toward the Governor's goal, there is room for increasing the use of E85. The state fleet currently includes approximately 2,500 flex-fuel vehicles that are capable of using E85 fuel, and there are more than 350 E85 retailers across the state. Nearly all E85 vehicles are marked with fuel door decals identifying E85 as the fuel of choice. If there are any questions concerning fuel compatibility or location of E85 fuel, please contact your agency fleet office or the Admin Fleet Services Division.

This report will be furnished to you quarterly. If you have any questions, please contact any member of the SmartFleet Committee.
