Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section 14.05, subd. 5, below is the report on obsolete, unnecessary and duplicative rules of the Department of Agriculture.

I. Status of rules identified as obsolete in 2008:

No rules were identified as obsolete in 2008.

II. Obsolete, unnecessary and duplicative rules for 2009:

1505.0730-1505.0750: These parts reference categories and definitions that were removed from the noxious weed law when it was amended in 2009.

1505.1300-1505.1450: These amendments refer to disposal of foreign refuse which is no longer a responsibility of the department. These activities are now conducted by USDA APHIS as part of their regulation of interstate and international movement of potential pests.
