Subject: Obsolete Rules Report Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section 14.05, subdivision 5.

Dear Ms. Timmons:

Minnesota Statutes, section 14.05, subdivision 5, states: "By December 1 of each year, an agency shall submit a list of specific agency rules to the governor, the legislative coordinating commission, the policy and funding committees and divisions with jurisdiction over the agency, and the revisor of statutes. The list must identify those rules that are obsolete and should be repealed. The list must also include an explanation of why the rule is obsolete and the agency's timetable for repeal."

At this time, we can identify no POST Board Rules that are obsolete, unnecessary, or duplicative and that should be repealed.

In last year's report, we went through an extensive review of current POST Board Rules found in Chapter 6700 and identified several sections as being obsolete, unnecessary, and duplicative. The current status of the rules is that a request for comments has been published, the SONAR is completed, and a dual notice is forthcoming.
