Dear Senator Bonoff:

Legislation passed during the 2013 session requires Minnesota State Colleges and Universities to adopt a policy recognizing, for applicants who are veterans, the applicant's veteran status as a positive factor in determining whether to grant admission to a graduate or professional academic degree program. I am pleased to inform you that at its March meeting our Board of Trustees is expected to adopt a policy in response to this requirement. Several of our universities have already developed policies to recognize veteran status as a positive factor in graduate school admission.

The 2013 legislation also requires the Board of Trustees to report to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees and divisions with jurisdiction over higher education policy and finance annually on the number of veterans who apply for a graduate or professional academic degree program and the number accepted. The first annual report in response to this requirement is attached.

Prior to the enactment of this legislation, most of our state universities did not collect data on veteran status. They are therefore unable to provide accurate data on veteran applications and admissions for the past fiscal year. However, all the universities have now begun to collect this information and will be able to provide accurate data for the next annual report. This effort will be facilitated by the development and implementation this spring of a systemwide graduate online application that will include a question about an applicant's veteran status.

We serve more than 10,000 veterans, active military, and National Guard members – a 54% increase since the 2008 fiscal year. We are proud of the strides our colleges and universities have made in providing an inviting and supportive educational environment for Minnesota veterans. Each of our colleges and universities has achieved Servicemember Opportunity Colleges certification. We have achieved national recognition for our innovative Veterans

Education Transfer System. Governor Dayton has awarded the system with Yellow Ribbon business status. We look forward to demonstrating our commitment to veterans at the graduate level as well as at the undergraduate level.
