Dairy Profit Teams

The dairy profit teams provide one-on-one guidance to dairy producers across the state, including comprehensive financial analysis, risk management education, and production enhancement advice.

In FY15: <u>Support and direct the Dairy Profit Teams to work with at least 270 farms statewide</u>. <u>Continue to stress utilizing 71 percent of the budget for team activities</u>.

Dairy Business Planning Grants

These grants provide matching dollars for producers to develop a business plan. Grants are capped at \$3,000 per producer. Applicants are continuing to evaluate modernization projects as well as testing for stray voltage.

In FY15: Work with 30 farms statewide, capped at \$3000 per application. Grant recipients required to provide a one to one match.

Administration

The administration for this program is a .1 FTE at MDA and includes office rental, benefits package, copier expenses and supplies.
