The Three-year Self-support Index

This measure tracks whether eligible adults are working an average of 30 or more hours per week or no longer receiving MFIP or DWP cash assistance during the quarter three years from a baseline quarter. Adults who left MFIP after reaching 60 counted months and those who left due to 100 percent sanction are only counted as a success if they were worked an average of 30 hours per week in their last month of eligibility or began receiving Supplemental Security Income after MFIP or DWP cash assistance ended. Cells associated with racial/ethnic or immigrant subgroups with fewer than 30 adults are not reported due to data privacy restrictions.

The TANF Work Participation Rate

This measure identifies the percentage of TANF funded MFIP cases that are fully engaged in employment or employment-related activities in a quarter, per federal activity requirements. The rates reported here are based on TANF funded MFIP cases with eligible, non-exempt adults from the quarter of January through March of 2013. Under legislation effective July 1, 2005, participants who were formerly exempt from Employment Services were included in the Work Participation Rate. Participants are grouped by eight racial/ethnic or immigrant subgroups.

Cells highlighted by shading indicate a potential problem -- the particular racial/ethnic or immigrant subgroup has a MFIP Work Participation Rate five percentage points or more below the rate of the White subgroup.

Cells associated with racial/ethnic or immigrant subgroups with fewer than 30 adults are not reported due to data privacy restrictions.
