## Re: Report Required Under Minn. Stat. § 15C.16 (2014)

Dear Chairs and Ranking Members:

As you know, the Minnesota False Claims Act ("MFCA"), Minn. Stat. §§ 15C.01-.16, became effective July 1, 2010. Section 15C.16 (2014) requires this Office to report to the chairs and ranking minority members of the Senate and House of Representative Committees with jurisdiction over state government finance by January 15 of each year on activities carried out under Chapter 15C during the prior calendar year. Pursuant to this requirement, I provide the following information:

- Sixty-three complaints were received in 2014, where a claim was made that included, in part, Minn. Stat. § 15C.05. Two of these complaints were filed exclusively under section 15C.05; the remaining complaints were filed primarily under the Federal False Claims Act.
- In 2014, there were 33 cases in which the Office either declined to intervene and/or the relators dismissed the case. Sixteen cases were settled with \$1,321,572.90 being disbursed to the Minnesota Department of Human Services pursuant to federal Medicaid fraud provisions. The Office currently has 140 cases pending in which the Office has previously intervened or is investigating.

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• In 2014, 1,469.2 attorney hours and 405.9 non-attorney hours were spent on the cases referenced above.

Please be advised that this Office continues to be a member of the National Association of Medicaid Fraud Control Units ("NAMFCU") and through this participation works in conjunction with other states and with the United States Department of Justice to pursue recoveries under the Federal False Claims Act.
