The Forty Fourth Annual Report of the
Minnesota State Board of Dental Examiners

Mr. President and Members of the Minnesota State Dental Association:

The last report of this Board was submitted in August, 1928 at the time of the National Convention in Minneapolis of the American Dental Association.

Since that time the Board has held one meeting- January, 1929 for the examination of applicants and the transaction of such other business as might regularly come before it. Fifteen applicants for dental and two for hygienist licenses were examined at the January meeting, and all having passed were granted licenses.

The election of officers at the Executive Meeting of the Board resulted in the election of Dr. Berton Featherstone of Red Wing as President and Dr. F. E. Cobb of Minneapolis as Secretary for the year 1929.

The Board desired to make known at this time the consumation of reciprocal relations with the States of North and South Dakota, these states fulfilling the requirements necessary in our state law for said relationship.

The retiring members of the Board whose second and final term expires under the law January 1, 1930 are: Dr. George O. Orr of St. Paul; Dr. Berton Featherstone of Red Wing and Dr. F. E. Cobb of Minneapolis, making it necessary for the State Association now convening to make recommendations to the Governor for appointments to fill the vacancies then existing.

Three complaints for the illegal practice of dentistry have been filed with the Secretary recently and are being investigated by the Board's attorney.
