MRAC VISION

We believe that:

- The arts strengthen communities;
- The arts stimulate diversity of expression, communication, and commemoration of communities and cultures; and
- All people should have opportunities to engage in the arts.

Accordingly, MRAC's **vision** for the region is that:

- ♦ Artists, arts organizations, and arts activities thrive.
- ♦ Art is integrated into the social fabric and identity of every community.
- ♦ Public value of the arts is understood and acted upon by community members, leaders and policy makers.

MRAC MISSION

The Metropolitan Regional Arts Council increases access to the arts in 7-county metropolitan communities by providing information, organizational support, and grants.

MRAC GOALS

- * MRAC will provide grant applicants and other constituents with clear, thorough, prompt and respectful service and assistance.
- ❖ MRAC will maintain transparent decision-making processes, and accessible public information.
- ❖ MRAC's programs and services will reflect its Mission, and achieve its Vision.

GRANT PROGRAMS

In FY 2015, MRAC received 838 applications and awarded 457 grants totaling \$3,214,221 to arts organizations and/or projects including a grant to VSA Minnesota for the ADA Access Improvement Grants for Metro Arts Organizations (which resulted in 16 grants). MRAC also received 346 applications from individual artists in the Next Step Fund program and awarded 37 grants totaling \$180,450 with funds from The McKnight Foundation. MRAC also provided 15 arts management training sessions and 32 grant application workshops.

Our Biennial Plan described 11 grant programs for FY 2015. Below is a brief description of each, with comments on any variances on actual activities. Please note that the overarching legacy goal(s) that each program and service addresses appear in *italics*.

• Arts Activities Support Grants

Grants of up to \$10,000 for arts project

Grants of up to \$10,000 for arts projects.

The arts are interwoven into every facet of community life.

People of all ages, ethnicities, and abilities participate in the arts.

The arts thrive in Minnesota.

Total Budget: \$1,311,000; \$139,910 from Appropriation, \$1,171,090 from Arts & Cultural Heritage Fund.

Actual: 143 grants, total of \$1,390,985; \$69,850 from Appropriation, \$1,321,135 from ACHF.

• **Community Arts** Grants

Grants of up to \$5,000 for arts projects, using a county allocation block grant system.

The arts are interwoven into every facet of community life.

People of all ages, ethnicities, and abilities participate in the arts.

The arts thrive in Minnesota.

Total budget: \$610,000; \$38,374 from Appropriation, \$571,626 from Arts & Cultural Heritage Fund.

Actual: 128 grants, total of \$612,744; \$106,600 from Appropriation, \$506,144 from ACHF.

Arts Learning Grants

Grants of up to \$10,000 for projects for people of all ages to develop knowledge, skills, and understanding of the arts, and to increase learning through the arts.

The arts are interwoven into every facet of community life.

People of all ages, ethnicities, and abilities participate in the arts.

The arts thrive in Minnesota.

Total budget: \$488,000, all from Arts & Cultural Heritage Fund.

Actual: 53 grants, total of \$498,636, all from ACHF.

ADA Access Improvement Fund

A partnership with VSA Minnesota, for grants up to \$15,000 to arts organizations that own or are the principal tenants of buildings to make capital improvements to fully accommodate people with disabilities.

The arts are interwoven into every facet of community life.

People of all ages, ethnicities, and abilities participate in the arts.

The arts thrive in Minnesota.

Total budget: \$220,000, all from Arts & Cultural Heritage Fund.

Actual: One grant of \$220,000 to VSA from ACHF; VSA awarded 16 grants.

• Organizational Development and Capital

Grants of up to \$10,000 for projects that strengthen the management and/or infrastructure of nonprofit arts groups, and for capital improvement projects.

The arts thrive in Minnesota.

Total budget: \$420,000, all from Appropriation.

Actual: 22 Organizational Development grants, 25 Capital grants, total of \$423,359, all from Appropriation.

• Management Consulting Fund; Management Training Fund; Emergency Accessibility Fund

Small grants with monthly deadlines for "bite-sized" projects to assist with focused organizational issues, increase access to professional development opportunities, and costs to enable groups to accommodate artists and audiences with disabilities on short notice.

The arts thrive in Minnesota.

Total budget for the Management Consulting Fund, Management Training Fund, and Emergency Accessibility programs: \$58,000; all from Appropriation.

Actual: 41 Management Consulting Fund grants, 42 Management Training Fund grants, 2 Emergency Accessibility grant, total of \$68,497, all from Appropriation.

MRAC Arts Achievement Award

Recognition of two organizations – one in the "metro" (Minneapolis and St. Paul) and one in the "greater metro" (Anoka, Carver, Dakota, Scott, Washington, Suburban Hennepin, Suburban Ramsey) areas of the region – that particularly exemplify MRAC's mission of incorporating the arts into the daily lives of communities.

The arts are interwoven into every facet of community life. People of all ages, ethnicities, and abilities participate in the arts. The arts thrive in Minnesota.

Total budget: \$10,000, all from the Appropriation.

Actual: 2 Awards of \$5,000 each, all from Appropriation.

• **Next Step Fund** Grants

MRAC's only grant program for individual artists provided grants up to \$5,000 to professional artists in any discipline for the purpose of career development and artistic achievement.

The arts thrive in Minnesota.

Total budget: \$181,000, all from the McKnight Foundation.

Actual: 37 grants, total of \$180,450, all from the McKnight Foundation.

NON GRANT PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

Training and networking opportunities have been very successful tools in reaching and serving MRAC constituent groups, particularly "greater metro" groups that are isolated and unaware of resources available to help them. As groups participate in training and convening activities they discover new ways – that are not necessarily dependent on grants – to bring the arts to their communities. These activities provide multiple opportunities for learning and connecting.

The arts thrive in Minnesota.

- LOCALS is a professional affinity group for art center/arts council managers in the seven-county region that meets several times a year and provides an opportunity to network, share best practices, and learn together, with guest speakers, on timely management topics. During FY 2015, the LOCALS group convened three times to explore:
 - Clarity, Impact, and Passion: How To Talk About What You Do in the Arts (21 people attended)
 - o Tapping the Power of Public Relations (29 people attended)
 - Balancing Act Maintaining Institutional Legacy & Contemporary Relevance (14 people attended)
- Workshops and Trainings are free seminars for nonprofit arts organizations in the seven-county region with budgets under \$400,000 (although people from outside of the region and from larger organizations are welcome to attend). These seminars provide training on topics that will help small arts organizations improve the management of their organizations, such as social media, online fundraising, strategic planning, Cultural Data Project and other financial planning tools, and program evaluation and outcomes.

Session topics are developed according to input from our constituents, and total attendance for the year was 640 people at 12 sessions. MRAC collaborates with other organizations such as MAP for Nonprofits, Nonprofits Assistance Fund, the University of St. Thomas, Next in Nonprofits, Access Philanthropy and others in organizing and presenting some of these workshops and trainings.

• MRAC's monthly e-newsletter provided stimulating and timely information for constituents and colleagues.

ARTS AND CULTURAL HERITAGE FUND PROGRAMS AND SERVICES OUTCOMES

MRAC's primary approach to the outcomes of our work aligns with the purposes of the Arts and Cultural Heritage Fund, and the guidelines for all of our programs are designed to elicit outcomes that will align with ACHF purposes:

Arts and Arts Access

Support for Minnesota artists and arts organizations in creating, producing, and presenting high-quality arts activities; to overcome barriers to accessing high-quality arts activities; and to instill the arts into the community and public life in this state.

Arts Education

For high-quality, age-appropriate arts education for Minnesotans of all ages to develop knowledge, skills, and understanding of the arts.

Arts and Cultural Heritage

For events and activities that represent the diverse ethnic and cultural arts traditions, including folk and traditional artists and art organizations, represented in this state.

The goal in MRAC's 2014 – 2015 Biennial Plan specific to Arts and Cultural Heritage Funds was for MRAC to **continue to serve the artistic, cultural and geographic diversity of the metropolitan area through grants and services.** The primary way that MRAC meets this goal is through grantmaking, which is summarized above. In addition, our Biennial Plan specified several Critical Success Factors toward achieving that goal:

- MRAC activity grants have a direct impact on constituents' ability to create successful arts projects that reach their target communities.
- MRAC's staff services, training programs and organizational grants help arts organizations strengthen and thrive.
- MRAC is accessible to its underrepresented communities in terms of relationship, funding, and services.
- MRAC staff are welcoming and informed.

We can report the following outcomes:

- <u>OUTCOME</u>: Many projects funded in FY 2015 are still in progress. Approximately 90% of grant recipients' final reports that have been submitted to date indicate that the project was artistically successful, reached the target constituency, and had community impact. (We continue to work hard in this area to get grantees to report on <u>outcomes</u> rather than <u>outputs</u>, in part by simplifying our final report forms, and in part by clarifying what we mean by outcomes in our grant application workshops and other direct contact with applicants.)
- <u>OUTCOME</u>: 92% of grant applicants responding to a survey sent to all FY 2014 grant applicants reported a satisfaction level of "excellent" or "good" with MRAC's grant application workshops, library, online process, and panel review process, and 94% reported a satisfaction level of "excellent" or "good" with MRAC staff interactions (because we were "between" communications/events coordinators Mara Miller left in January 2015, and Raeisha Williams was hired in April we were unable to conduct a survey of applicants in FY 2015).
- <u>OUTCOME</u>: We continue to get applications from groups that have never applied before. While the **number** of new applicants decreased from 100 in 2014 to 95 in 2015 (not necessarily a bad thing; the number of new applicants should not necessarily always increase), the **percentage** of new applicants who are from under-represented communities increased from 39% in 2014 to 41% in 2015. (At MRAC, under-represented is determined primarily in terms of geographic location, and obvious cultural specificity. The staff and board of directors, as part of organizational strategic planning that began with the development of the biennial plan for fiscal years 2016 and 2017, are engaged in clarifying, analyzing, and assessing how "under-represented" is or should be determined.)

ARTS ADVOCACY, EDUCATION AND LEADERSHIP

MRAC'S goal of increasing public awareness and support for the arts is critical not only for the survival of legislative funding, but also for helping to ensure that art happens in every community.

For the past several years, MRAC has conducted "Big Check" events at which we present large checks to grantees in the extremities of our region. Legislators representing the grantees' districts are also invited. This year we held the events in St. Anthony and Bloomington.

MRAC actively recruits constituents to attend Arts Advocacy Day and to join MCA to stay informed about advocacy issues.

MRAC staff members are regularly sought as community resources, serving on panels, speaking about arts policy and impact, delivering workshops, and participating in study groups or on task forces around local and statewide arts issues.

MRAC INFRASTRUCTURE

The MRAC staff of seven people (5.85 full time equivalent), includes Executive Director Jeff Prauer; Program Directors Bob Burns, Greg Nielsen, and Shannon Forney; Grants and Operations Coordinator Katie Kaufmann; Communications and Events Coordinator Raeisha Williams; and Program Associate Kelly Affeldt. Christine Murakami Noonan chaired the Board of Directors in FY 2015; Chris is a marketing professional with the Minnesota State Fair. She was succeeded on July 1, 2015 by Peter Leggett, executive director of Walker West Music Academy.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Please note that the attached financial report shows a surplus of \$6,460, and \$19,133 of income under "Other Funds." The \$19,133 was a surplus from FY 2014; combined with all other income for FY 2015, the difference between income and expenses for FY 2015, and for the biennium, equals \$6,460, which MRAC will return to the Minnesota State Arts Board following the anticipated approval of our FY 2015 audit by the MRAC Board of Directors on October 27, 2015.
