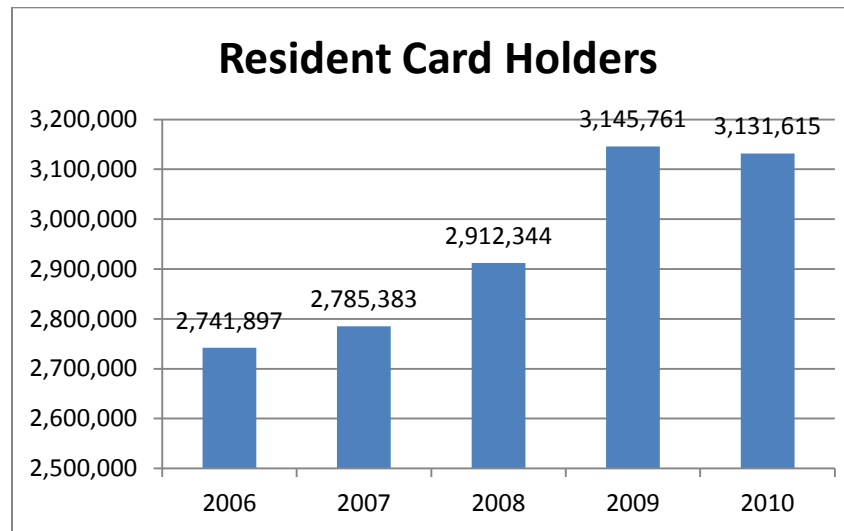

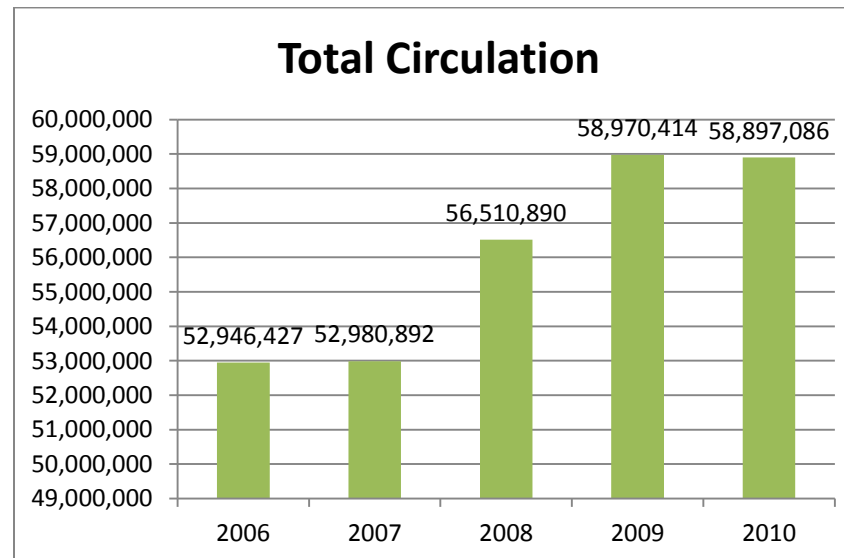

State Population Percent Change 2006-2010: 1%

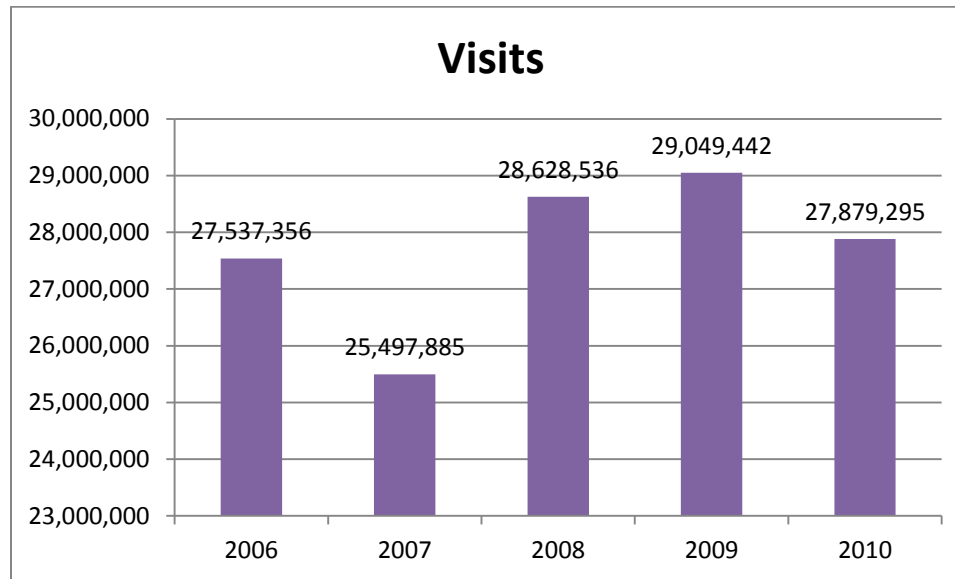


Resident Card Holders Percent Change 2006-2010: 14%

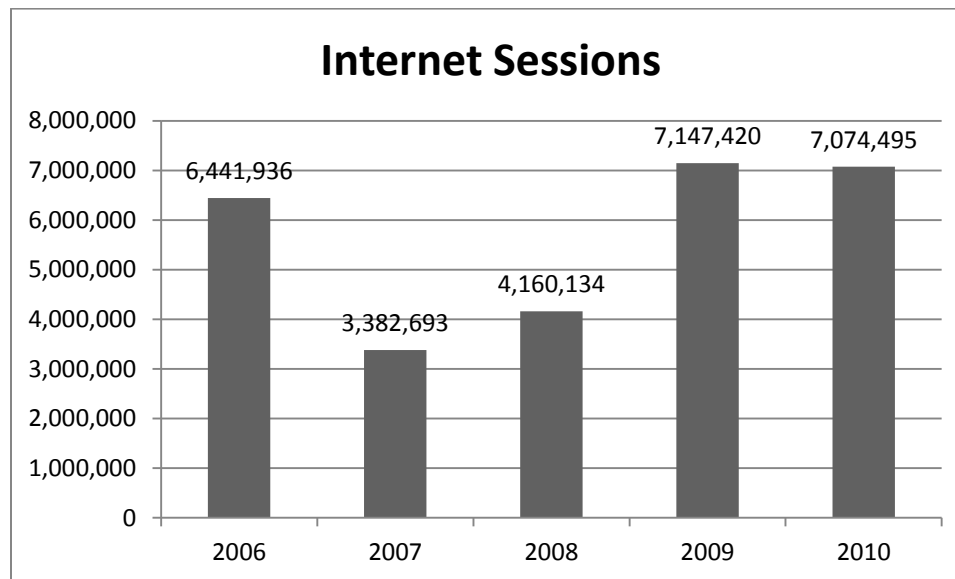


Total Circulation Percent Change 2006-2010: 11%

MINNESOTA PUBLIC LIBRARIES AT A GLANCE 2006-2010

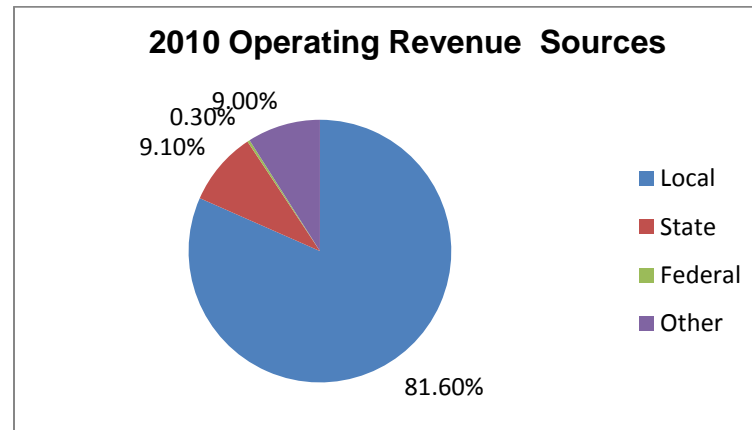


Total Visit Percent Change 2006-2010: 1%

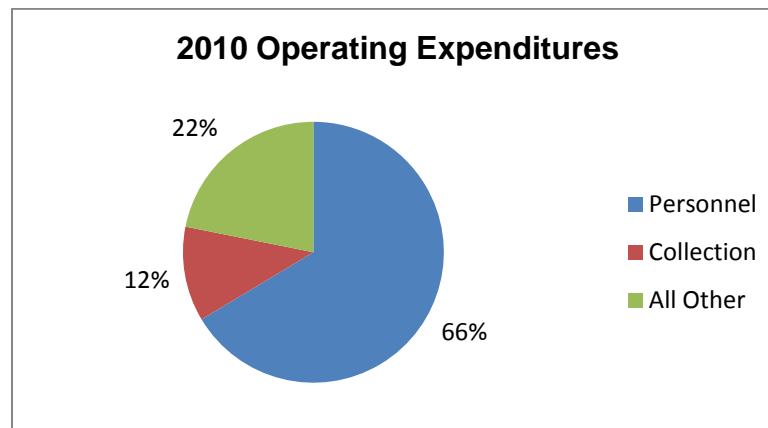


Total Internet Sessions Percent Change 2006-2010: 10%

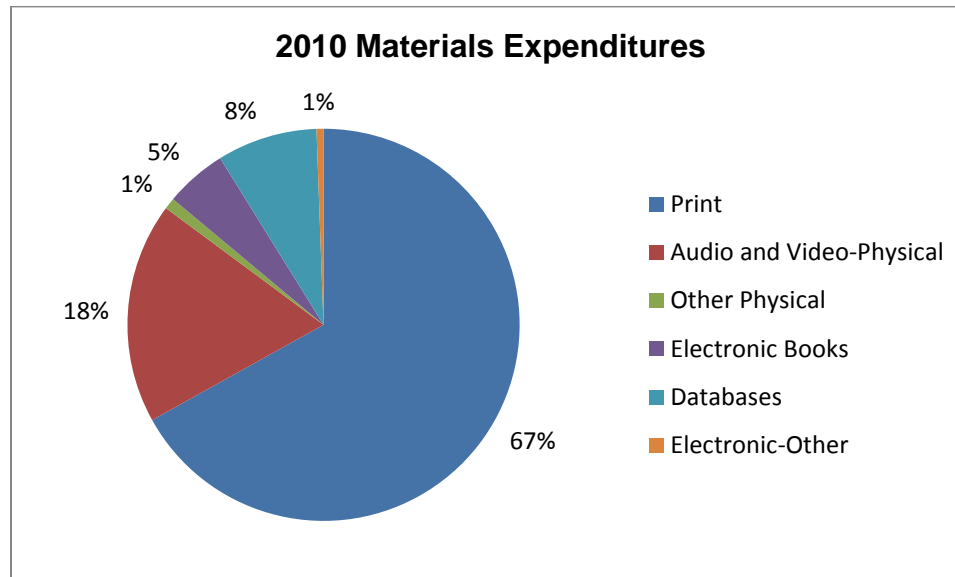

STATE LIBRARY SERVICES

State Library Services, a division of the Minnesota Department of Education, is the Minnesota state library agency. The state library provides leadership and support to the Minnesota library community in planning, developing and implementing high-quality library and information services statewide. State Library Services administers federal and state grants-in-aid programs for libraries.

Vision Statement

State Library Services, acting as the State Library Agency for the Minnesota Department of Education, leads in developing, planning and implementing excellent library and information services statewide. The State Library Agency ensures that Minnesota libraries and their communities have access to the present and future information resources they need through partnerships with public information and cultural institutions.

Mission Statement

To provide the library services and information resources needed by Minnesotans, the Minnesota State Library Agency will:

- Administer statewide library services;
- Develop and implement standards of accountability of state and federal funding recipients;
- Develop and implement statewide and regional library services, initiatives and programs;
- Implement statewide planning and evaluation for library development for all types of libraries;
- Develop and implement standards for libraries;
- Provide leadership for career and education opportunities;
- Certify library eligibility for state and federal assistance;
- Advise the governor, the legislature and regional and local governing bodies on library-related issues; and
- Facilitate partnerships between libraries and other agencies.

Minnesotans deserve equitable access to library services and information resources regardless of geographic location, economic or social status, cultural background, age, or level of intellectual or physical ability. The library network of trustees, friends, librarians, administrators and their communities must work together to voice their concerns and support for equitable access to their funding entities, including their congressional, legislative, county and city officials. This collaboration will help to foster a more informed citizenry, a stronger democracy, and more economically viable communities statewide.

NOTES AND GLOSSARY

1. All data is as of December 31, 2010.
2. Officially, as cited on 2010 Statistical Highlights, page i, Minnesota has 138 public library administrative agencies responsible for 359 library buildings. Data in the subsequent tables indicates 141 administrative units. The additional three units include data from the Metropolitan Library Service Agency (MELSA), Southeastern Libraries Cooperating (SELCO), and Traverse des Sioux Regional Library System. These three agencies do not provide any direct public library service. However, omitting their data would provide misleading data because of the integral services they provide that serve the public. Two examples would be the number of databases and downloadable eBooks they purchase on behalf of their member libraries. The number of materials available to the public would be undercounted without including the materials provided by the three regional public library systems. When certain data sets do not apply, such as number of visits or reference transactions, they enter zero (0) and listed as having responded.
3. The state legislature appropriated \$4.2 million from the Clean Water, Land and Legacy Amendment funds to the 12 regional public library systems for the first time in FY2010. This amount is included in their state revenue funds. Libraries that received grants from their respective regional public library systems for Legacy activities entered the funds in the Other revenue category to avoid double counting the dollar amounts as state funds.
4. The funding from the Clean Water, Land and Legacy Amendment accounts for much of the increase in programming and attendance between 2009 and 2010.
5. The state dollar amount does not include the \$900,000 annual appropriation to support the Electronic Library for Minnesota databases, which are available at all affiliated public libraries.

7. Populations of the 12 regional public library systems are based on the 2010 census for county population. In 16 cases, cities straddle two or more regional library systems' boundaries. The regional system populations are adjusted so that a city's entire population is located in the respective regional system to which the library belongs.
8. Individual library populations are estimated by the library directors. Because of overlapping estimates by directors, often the sum of populations of members of a regional system exceeds the population of the regional public library system.

10. A federated system is a regional library system in which the member libraries are individually functioning administrative entities. A consolidated system is a multi-county system consisting of one administration with oversight over the public libraries within its jurisdiction.
11. An unaffiliated library is one whose city has decided not to be a member of a regional public library system. Their status prohibits them from receiving any state-derived benefits. The five cities in this status are Clarkfield, Crosby, East Grand Forks, Hendricks, and Taylors Falls.
12. Because the Faribault County Library ceased in 2009, the word “city” after Faribault is no longer provided to distinguish between Faribault County Library and the Buckham Memorial Library in Faribault.
13. Reciprocal borrowing is defined as occurring when an individual whose residence is in one regional public library system personally borrows materials from a library located in a different regional public library system. An interlibrary loan occurs when a request for materials is made remotely and the material is transported to the library of choice of the individual.
