Dear Ms. Elmore:

Pursuant to Minn. Statute 462.393 Subd.2, please find enclosed a copy of the Upper Minnesota Valley Regional Development Commission's five-year self-evaluation report. This evaluation was conducted by means of an electronic community survey. The survey was emailed to 143 public officials (mayors, tribal chair, county commissioners, school board superintendents, city manager/clerks, county administrators, county engineers, RDC board members) in the region. And 50 responded (35%). A full copy of the survey is attached for your review.

Of those responding to specific questions:

- 46% of respondents viewed themselves as either very knowledgeable or knowledgeable about the Commission. 36% were somewhat knowledgeable and 18% not knowledgeable.
- 90% had worked with the UMVRDC over the last five years.
- 57 % felt the UMVRDC had been very responsive and 43 % felt the UMVRDC had been responsive to their requests.
- 74 % were completely satisfied and 23 % somewhat satisfied with the service they received from the UMVRDC.
- 94 % judged the overall quality of service as good to excellent, while 3% judged it as fair and 3% did not know.
- 100 % rated the effectiveness and professional capabilities of the UMVRDC staff to be good to excellent.
- 13% described the cost for services as too high, 77% as about right, and 10% as inexpensive.



A summary chart of the issues that were identified as critical and urgent to the region is attached.






Q3 Which of the following best describes what jurisdiction you represent?









Q6 How do you judge the overall quality of service that the UMVRDC provides?






