

Greater Minnesota Business Public Infrastructure Grant (BDPI)

A list of BDPI projects since 2011 is provided along with their award amounts and type of project. These projects supported 8965 jobs and leveraged \$45,405,575. We do not keep records of how much of that leverage is private versus public.

Small Cities Development Program (SCDP)

DEED has awarded \$114,055,945 of SCDP funds since 2011. Over that period, \$148,859,768 has been leveraged with 4290 units of housing being restored. We do not have information about how much of that leverage is comprised of private funds.
