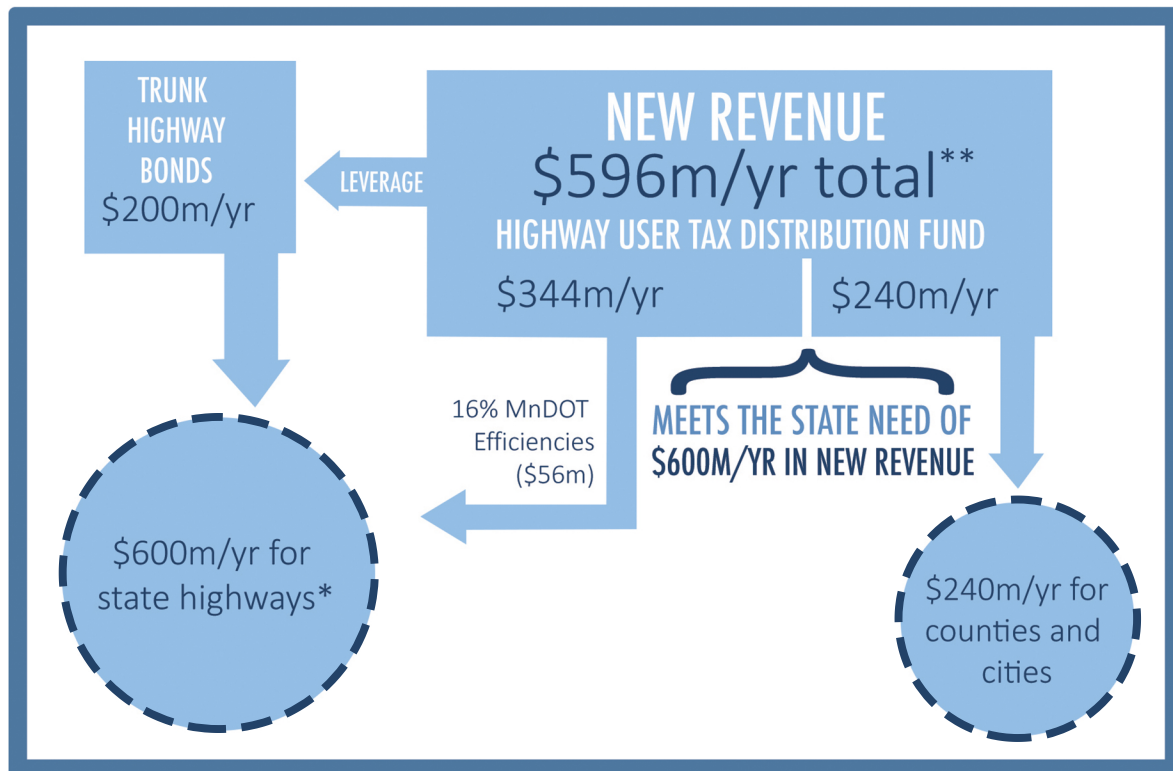


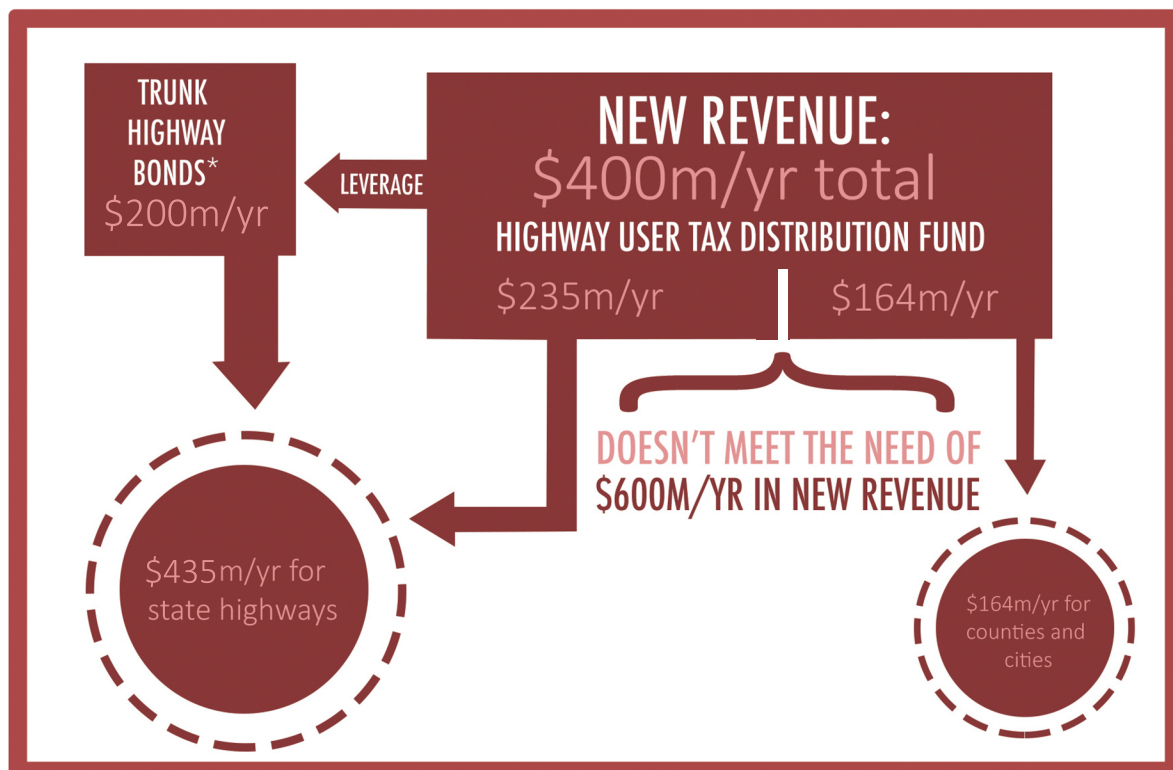
Governor Dayton's Transportation Proposal:



* includes operations, planning, state road construction, and debt service

**Revenue from fuel not used for transportation on public roads (such as snow mobiles, ATVs, boats, etc.) is transferred to Department of Natural Resources accounts related to those activities. Estimated at \$12 million.

House GOP Transportation Proposal:



*The Republicans' transportation proposal includes \$200 million in trunk highway bonds, however their yearly total varies from year-to-year, totaling only \$1.3 billion over ten years. This breaks down in the following way: \$200 million/yr for the first six years; \$100 million in the seventh year; and unspecified amounts in the final three years.
