- WHEREAS: Deputy Sandberg was killed in the line of duty on Sunday, October 18, 2015; and
- WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota, with its deepest gratitude, recognizes Deputy Sandberg for his dedicated service to, and sacrifice for, his fellow citizens of Minnesota; and thoughts and prayers are with his family, friends, and all who knew him.
