# Proclamation

- WHEREAS: The needs of the people of Minnesota are great: for jobs; for the safe return of our troops; and for health, hope, and reconciliation for all; and
- WHEREAS: The assets of our state are abundant: rich farm land, beautiful lakes, strong families, and an unmatched heritage of hard-work, sacrifice, patriotism, innovative ideas, and community service; and
- WHEREAS: We desire an inclusive, broadminded, and tolerant society, and as Oliver Wendell Holmes wrote, "The great act of faith is when man decides that he is not God"; and
- WHEREAS: From the earliest days of our nation, through war and depressions and natural disasters, to the recent events of September 11, the conflicts overseas, and loss of our fallen heroes in the military and law enforcement, our people have turned to prayer to seek wisdom, guidance, and strength and to express thanksgiving; and
- WHEREAS: The Congress of the United States has designated the first Thursday in May as the National Day of Prayer.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 3, 2012 to be:
