## **Introduction**

The Water Infrastructure Funding (WIF) program (Minnesota Statutes, section 446A.072) provides supplemental grants to municipalities with high cost water infrastructure projects that meet affordability criteria established by statute. Under Minnesota Statutes, section 446A.072, subdivision 11, the PFA must report to the appropriate legislative committees by February 1 of each even-numbered year on grant needs for projects under this section.

In 2017 the WIF program statutes were amended to, for the first time, make drinking water projects eligible for WIF grants in addition to wastewater projects. The program name was also changed from the Wastewater Infrastructure Funding program to the Water Infrastructure Funding program.

The WIF program is administered by the Minnesota Public Facilities Authority (PFA). The PFA awards WIF grants in conjunction with loans from the PFA's Clean Water and Drinking Water Revolving Fund (CWRF and DWRF) programs or the U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Rural Development grant and loan program.

Municipalities seeking WIF grants must have their projects listed on the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency's (MPCA's) Project Priority List (PPL) for wastewater projects, and the Minnesota Department of Health's (MDH's) PPL for drinking water projects. The PPLs rank projects that are expected to proceed with construction within a five year period according to environmental and public health factors.

## **WIF Affordability Criteria**

WIF grants are based on affordability criteria that compare the annual cost per household of the wastewater or drinking water system to the median household income of the municipality. While the WIF program is potentially available to all cities, WIF grant recipients tend to be smaller communities which generally have higher costs per household. In order to most effectively use limited grant funding, to be eligible for WIF municipalities must also apply for grants from other sources for which they may be eligible.

The WIF affordability criteria are established in Minnesota Statutes, Section 446A.072, subdivision 5a. For projects receiving PFA loans, the average annual system cost per household is determined by taking the annual operation and maintenance cost of the wastewater or drinking water system plus annual debt service costs from past capital improvements, divided by the total number of users. When the average annual system cost, including the cost of the new project, exceeds 1.4 percent of median household income for wastewater projects, or 1.2 percent for drinking water projects, the project is eligible to receive a WIF grant to offset a portion of the PFA loan. The amount of the grant is equal to 80 percent of the amount needed to reduce the average residential system cost to the 1.4 percent or 1.2 percent threshold, up to a maximum grant of 80% of eligible project cost or \$5,000,000. The WIF eligible project cost is determined by multiplying the total project cost by the Essential Project Component percentage calculated by MPCA or MDH, which represents that portion of the project needed to meet existing needs versus growth.

Similar to the PFA process, small rural communities, generally under 1,000 population, with median household incomes below the non-metro state average may apply to USDA Rural Development for wastewater grants and loans. Projects that are eligible to receive a USDA Rural Development grant based on the Rural Development affordability criteria may receive a WIF matching grant for up to 65% of the total grant need determined by USDA Rural Development. This state-federal partnership allows state WIF funds to assist more projects, makes it easier for small communities to access funding, reduces state administrative expenses, and helps USDA Rural Development maximize the federal funds allocated to Minnesota communities.

Whether a grant is awarded in conjunction with a PFA loan or as a match to USDA Rural Development funding, the maximum WIF grant is \$5,000,000 per project or \$20,000 per connection, whichever is less, unless specifically approved by law. (Under Minnesota Statutes, section 446A.072, subdivision 5a(d), the per connection cap rises to \$25,000 in cases where construction costs are increased due to bedrock or karst geology and the discharge limits are greater than secondary treatment.)

### **WIF Funding Process**

The WIF program does not have a separate application process. Projects are evaluated for grant eligibility as part of the application process for PFA loans or USDA Rural Development funding.

WIF grants are awarded to eligible projects based on their priority rank on the MPCA or MDH project priority lists and their readiness to proceed. Under Minnesota Statutes, section 446A.072, subdivision 3(d), each fiscal year the PFA reserves available funds for eligible projects when they are certified by the MPCA or MDH, or when the project receives a funding commitment from USDA Rural Development. Funds are reserved in an amount based on the project cost estimate when the project is certified or the as-bid cost, whichever is less, and awarded when construction begins.

### **System Replacement Fund Requirement**

Under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, section 446A.072, subdivision 12, WIF recipients must establish a system replacement fund and annually deposit \$.050 per 1000 gallons of flow to be used for major rehabilitation, expansion, or replacement of the wastewater or drinking water system. The funds are held by the municipality and must remain in a dedicated system replacement account for the life of the corresponding PFA or USDA-RD loan, unless use of the funds is approved by the PFA for eligible capital improvements. WIF recipients submit an annual certification to the PFA documenting their replacement fund deposits and balances. A recipient is not required to maintain a fund balance greater than the amount of the grant received.

### **Estimated WIF Needs**

In fall 2017, the PFA surveyed municipalities with projects on the 2018 PPLs and received updated information from 76 projects on the clean water PPL and 150 projects on the drinking water PPL. This data, together with previously submitted project information and other data

compiled by the PFA, has been used to calculate estimated WIF grant needs based on the program affordability criteria.

Tables 1 (wastewater projects) and 2 (drinking water projects) on the following pages identify potential WIF eligible projects on the 2018 PPLs. In each table, projects are divided into three groups. The first are projects in priority order that were certified by June 30, 2017 and therefore have WIF funds reserved or awarded (2017 carryover projects). The second group are potential WIF eligible projects in priority order that are listed on the 2018 Intended Use Plan for CWRF or DWRF loans, or have submitted Preliminary Engineering Reports to USDA Rural Development and are therefore potentially eligible for a Rural Development funding commitment in FY 2018. The third group in each table are other projects on the 2018 PPLs where preliminary information indicates a WIF need but which are not yet ready to proceed.

Tables 1 and 2 also show CWRF and DWRF principal forgiveness grant funds that will be used to help address WIF needs. The PFA receives annual federal capitalization grants for the CWRF and DWRF revolving loan funds. Federal appropriation language allows a small portion of the federal funds to be awarded as principal forgiveness grants based on state affordability criteria. PFA CWRF and DWRF statutes reference the state WIF criteria to be used for these federal principal forgiveness grants.

As shown in Table 1 on pages 6-7, the total cumulative WIF grant need for wastewater projects on the 2018 MPCA PPL is currently estimated at \$106 million. This amount will likely grow as projects on the 2018 Clean Water Intended Use Plan submit their formal loan applications and additional information is received on other projects. In 2017 the Legislature appropriated \$40 million for WIF grants for wastewater projects. This amount will fund WIF needs for all 2017 carryover projects and some of the 2018 project needs. The dotted line on Table 1 indicates how far down the 2018 list the available funds will reach based on current estimates. However projects on the 2018 Intended Use Plan have until March 29, 2018 to submit their formal loan applications. Additional WIF needs may be identified and grant estimates are likely to change.

As shown in Table 2 on pages 8-10, the total cumulative WIF grant need for drinking water projects on the 2018 MDH PPL is currently estimated at \$80 million. This amount will likely grow as projects on the 2018 Drinking Water Intended Use Plan submit their formal loan applications and additional information is received on other projects. In 2017 the Legislature appropriated \$15 million for WIF grants for drinking water projects. As indicated by the dotted line in Table 2, this amount will only meet the WIF needs for the 2017 carryover projects. WIF needs for all 2018 projects and beyond will require additional appropriations.
