


STATE of MINNESOTA

WHEREAS:	On October 28-30, 2016, Rally 2016: The National Land Conservation Conference will be held in Minneapolis, Minnesota; and
WHEREAS:	This year marks the 29 th Anniversary of The National Land Conservation Conference, an opportunity for land trust and conservation leaders from every state and many foreign countries to convene, assess and celebrate conservation; explore the important trends; and plan for future conservation efforts in communities; and
WHEREAS:	The work of land trusts benefit farmers, ranchers, and sustainable food supplies; the health of rivers, lakes, and supplies of high quality drinking water; walkers, hikers, bicyclists, and anyone who enjoys outdoor recreation; people who love scenic and historic sites; local economies and tax bases; and the current and coming generations of Americans; and
WHEREAS:	The Minnesota Land Trust, the Minnesota Chapter of the Nature Conservancy, and the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources are among the hosts of Rally 2016; and
WHEREAS:	The Land Trust Alliance serves as the voice and champion for the nation's 1,200 land trusts that have conserved more than 50 million acres of land through the commitment of five million members, 15,000 volunteer board members, 100,000 other volunteers, and 12,000 staff members; and
WHEREAS:	The nation's land trusts exist to save the places people love by strengthening land conservation across America, increasing the pace of land conservation, enhancing the quality of conservation, and creating the laws and resources needed to defend protected land over time.
