## Proclamation

WHEREAS: National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI) Minnesota, the state's largest advocacy organization,

seeks to improve the lives of children and adults living with mental illness and their families

through providing education, support, and advocacy; and

WHEREAS: The seeds of the organization were planted in 1976 when a small group of advocates challenged

state policy to close Hastings State Hospital without allocating any funds to develop community

mental health services; and

WHEREAS: The "Kitchen Table" Coalition developed a mental health pilot program, Sharing Life in the

Community (SLIC), and organized a constituency of sufficient size and strength which resulted in

the Minnesota State Legislature providing funding; and

WHEREAS: The same group of advocates originated Minnesota's first self-help family support group called,

Families of the Emotionally Disturbed United for Progress (FED-UP); and

WHEREAS: It formally organized in 1977 as the Mental Health Advocates Coalition of Minnesota, later joining

with others to found the National Alliance on Mental Illness; and

WHEREAS: NAMI Minnesota is celebrating its 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary on May 6, 2017; and

WHEREAS: By carrying out its mission, it has increased the public and professional understanding of mental

illness, confronted discrimination, provided leadership in building our state's mental health

system, and provided hope to countless individuals and their families; and

WHEREAS: NAMI Minnesota, in celebration of its anniversary, has visited 40 cities across the state to

document 40 stories of its founders and leaders; and

WHEREAS: NAMI Minnesota continues to work statewide to organize volunteers through its local affiliates to

carry out education classes, lead support groups, advocate for desperately needed community

mental health services, and is a voice for change.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, May 6, 2017, as:

in the State of Minnesota.
