Proclamation

WHEREAS: Vitiligo is an autoimmune disorder characterized by white patches of skin and

loss of pigment cells; and

WHEREAS: Vitiligo may be hereditary and is the most common disorder of skin coloration;

and

WHEREAS: The cause of Vitiligo is unknown, but affects approximately 3 million Americans

and about two percent of the world's population; and

WHEREAS: People with Vitiligo also may be affected by sun sensitivity, thyroid disease,

pernicious anemia, Addison's disease, and lupus.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, June 25, 2017, as:

VITILIGO AWARENESS DAY

in the State of Minnesota.
