- WHEREAS: 4-H youths are two times more likely to make healthy choices, four times more likely to contribute to their communities, and two times more likely to be civically active.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, August 26, 2017, as:


