Governor Dayton's Budget for New Ulm

The budget signed into law this year by Governor Mark Dayton is fair, responsible, and makes critical investments in Minnesota's future. New school initiatives help provide a world-class education for Minnesota students. The budget also invests in proven job creation strategies.

For the past decade, middle-class Minnesotans have struggled under ever-increasing property taxes. But the Governor's budget will deliver significant property tax relief.

Additionally, this budget delivers tax fairness for Minnesotans by asking the wealthiest two percent of Minnesotans to pay their fair share in taxes. This will allow for essential investments in Minnesota communities like New Ulm, including new resources for New Ulm schools and students, new support for job creation, and funding for needed middle class property tax relief.

Dayton Budget for New Ulm – By the Numbers

- \$454 New per student funding for New Ulm Public Schools
- \$884,000 Total new funding for New Ulm Public Schools
- \$200,000 Total state grant funding for area college students
- \$111,000 Increase in 2014 LGA for city of New Ulm
- \$138,000 Increase in County Program Aid for Brown County
- \$1.3M Total new investment in New Ulm
