- WHEREAS: Snowmobiling represents a large part of Minnesota's winter tourism industry and contributes greatly to the state's economy; and
- WHEREAS: The Minnesota United Snowmobilers Association and the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources, along with their volunteer safety instructors, have joined together to educate the public about safe and responsible snowmobiling practices; and
- WHEREAS: Responsible riding practices, such as obeying state laws, operating at safe speeds, and abstaining from alcohol consumption, help make Minnesota's snowmobiling experience safe and enjoyable.
