- WHEREAS: Many members of the Royal Lao Armed Forces paid the ultimate sacrifice, and gave their lives in defense of freedom and liberty; and
- WHEREAS: The United States of America and the state of Minnesota owe a debt of gratitude to those in the Royal Lao Armed Forces, who served courageously and with honor in collaboration with the United States Armed Forces.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, March 21, 2015, as:

ROYAL LAO ARMED FORCES DAY

in the state of Minnesota.
