Dear Senators and Representatives:

Minnesota statutes, section 5.38 provides in part:

The secretary of state may enter into agreements with a local governmental unit to provide a technological service or project to enhance the state's election system. The secretary of state and the local governmental unit shall agree to the amount of consideration to be paid under the agreement. In addition, the secretary of state may accept federal funds for election purposes.

The Office of the Secretary of State is required to report by each January 15 "the total amounts received in the preceding calendar year, the sources of those funds, and the uses to which those funds were or will be put." Minn. Stat. § 5.38.

As required by section 5.38, the Office of the Secretary of State reports that it received \$6,595,610 in federal funds from the 2018 HAVA Election Security Fund, authorized under Title I Section 101 of the Help America Vote Act (HAVA) of 2002. These funds were deposited and are currently accruing interest in the HAVA account established by Minn. Stat. § 5.30, subd. 1. However, the Office of Secretary of State cannot use these funds until the legislature authorizes their use under Minn. Stat. § 5.30, subd. 2.

Pending authorization for use, these funds will be used for election purposes consistent with the requirements found in Title III of the Help America Vote Act of 2002, including the following activities:

- 1. Modernize the statewide voter registration system;
- 2. Improve accessibility;
- 3. Prepare training materials and train local election officials;
- 4. Implement security improvements for election systems; and
- 5. Fund other activities that will improve the security of elections.

These funds, pending authorization, are onetime and available until September 30, 2023.
