Subject: Annual Report on Obsolete, Unnecessary or Duplicative Rules as Required by Minnesota Statutes, Section 14.05, Subdivision 5

Dear Governor Walz, Senators, Representatives, Director Hubinger, and Revisor Inman:

Minnesota Statutes, section 14.05, subdivision 5, directs the Board of Cosmetology to report to you by December 1 of each year whether any of its rules are obsolete, unnecessary, or duplicative of other state or federal statutes or rules. At this time, there are no rules declared as obsolete, unnecessary, or duplicative of other state or federal statutes or rules.

Minnesota Statutes, section 3.197, requires that a report to the legislature must contain the cost of preparing the report. The cost of preparing this report was approximately \$38.33.
