

The funds will be used for the purchase of foaming units to aid in the avian influenza emergency response.

You are receiving this notification based on the reporting requirement in law (Laws of 2015, Special Session 1, Article 1, Chapter 4, Section 7), which requires Minnesota Management and Budget to notify the Legislative Advisory Commission of anticipated federal funds for avian influenza.
