Legislative Charge

This annual report is mandated by <u>Minnesota Statutes</u>, <u>section 15.0395</u>, (https://www.revisor.mn.gov/statutes/cite/15.0395), which provides:

15.0395 INTERAGENCY AGREEMENTS AND INTRA-AGENCY TRANSFERS.

- (a) By October 15, 2018, and annually thereafter, the head of each agency must provide reports to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over the department or agency's budget on:
 - (1) interagency agreements or service-level agreements and any renewals or extensions of existing interagency or service-level agreements with another agency if the cumulative value of those agreements is more than \$100,000 in the previous fiscal year; and,
 - (2) transfers of appropriations between accounts within or between agencies, if the cumulative value of the transfers is more than \$100,000 in the previous fiscal year.

The report must include the statutory citation authorizing the agreement, transfer or dollar amount, purpose, and effective date of the agreement, the duration of the agreement, and a copy of the agreement.

(b) As used in this section, "agency" includes the departments of the state listed in section <u>15.01</u> (https://www.revisor.mn.gov/statutes/cite/15.01), a multimember state agency in the executive branch described in section <u>15.012</u> (https://www.revisor.mn.gov/statutes/cite/15.012), paragraph (a), the Office of MN.IT Services, and the Office of Higher Education.

Introduction

Attached to this report document are two spreadsheets. The first spreadsheet, titled *Interagency Agreements or Service-Level Agreements That Collectively Total More Than \$100,000 in FY 19*, provides details on MDE's use of interagency agreements in state fiscal year 2019. We included interagency agreements that crossed state fiscal years if any funds were used in state fiscal year 2019 and the total of the agreement was more than \$100,000.
