RP Online Educational Sessions, 2020

The School Climate Center, in collaboration with River Bottom Resources, the Minneapolis Legal Rights Center and Peacemaker Resources, offered Restorative Practices Online, six hour sessions, June 15-17 and June 22-24, 2020. The online sessions were centered on Building the Restorative Impulse for people new to restorative practices and Restorative Coaching for experienced practitioners.

Peacemaker Resources provided technical assistance to the trainers regarding Zoom access and use. We marketed the trainings to our contacts locally, and supported MDE by identifying circle trainers from the area. We worked with MDE and the other community partners in re-designing the trainings into online educational sessions.
