## Teacher Mentorship & Retention of Effective Teachers Program Narrative

Saint Paul Public Schools (SPPS) used the Teacher Mentorship and Retention of Effective Teachers Grant funds to pay mentor stipends for March, April, and May 2020. The Mentor Mentee Program was budgeted to support 250 new educators for the 2019-20 academic year, but the number of new educators increased to over 350. The grant allowed SPPS to continue the Mentor Mentee Program without having to adjust or reduce mentoring support. A full-year mentoring partnership is a minimum of 20 hours of support and a \$700 stipend to the mentor, whereas a half-year partnership is a minimum of 10 hours of support and a \$350 mentor stipend. Both mentees and mentors get clock hours toward relicensure. Mentees who successfully complete the Mentor Mentee Program are also awarded in-service credits that can be used towards a SPPS lane change.

SPPS believes that increasing teacher diversity through innovative recruitment, training, and retention efforts will increase student achievement, narrow the achievement gap, and build more authentic partnerships with students and families. These efforts include the Educator Support Pathway (ESP), which is designed to support and provide feedback to new teachers during their first years of teaching. The ESP provides professional learning opportunities that deepen educators' abilities to personalize learning and create a safe, equitable learning environment. Designed by SPPS and Saint Paul Federation of Educators (SPFE), the ESP leads to the achievement of tenure for eligible positions under the teaching bargaining unit. Tenure-track educators complete professional development through a cohort model that meets each year of probation called a "collaborative cohort." Professional development areas in the collaborative cohort include academic language, content-specific guidance, equity, personalized learning in a 1:1 environment, positive climate and culture, and universal access.

The Mentor Mentee Program is part of the ESP first-year support. The Mentor Mentee Program is individualized, differentiated, and flexible to meet the professional growth goals of educators new to the field of education and those new to SPPS. The program seeks to provide an effective transition into an education career in SPPS through:

- Development of a collegial culture within the school and across the district
- Support for instruction and/or professional practices to increase professional success and inspire students to think critically, pursue their dreams and change the world
- Ongoing growth and reflection of instruction and/or professional practices

Educators have the opportunity to develop a mentor-mentee relationship with differentiated activities that may include observations with feedback, job shadowing, review of student work/data, discussions around professional goals, and other individualized support.

For SY19-20, 341 probationary educators participated in the Mentor Mentee Program including 333 during the time of the grant. Mentors reported 6,402 collaborative hours for the school year. Of the mentoring pool, 50% of mentors were new to the program and mentoring for the first time, 27% returned with one previous year of mentoring, and 22% returned with two or more years of mentoring.

Mentors provide collaborative reports to document the work together throughout the school year and mentees provide reflections on the collaborative work related to their professional goals. The mentor collaboration report also documents the number of support hours outside of the contracted workday. A random sampling of responses is highlighted below.

Mentee Reflection:

- Having a mentor was a blessing! XXX's knowledge of due process paperwork and her advice for classroom management/creative lessons help me immensely. Collaborating with XXX has made me feel more prepared for the upcoming school year. She gave me great

ideas for meeting individual needs with fun classroom activities, showed me different ways to keep track of data, put me at ease when I was feeling overwhelmed, walked me through my first IEP meeting, helped me keep better organized, and handle the due process responsibilities. [elementary SPED teacher]

- My mentor and I have collaboratively worked to develop a student academic and social emotional needs sheet for reference truly at a glance. Working with over 500 students that will pass through my classroom, a very quick glance is a good reminder for who the students are and when they need when they walk into the art room. We have had observations at Global Arts Magnet and Saint Anthony Park. These were valuable experiences that enriched my own teaching because I was able to view structures and routines from other elementary art teachers in the district. I have been a department of one in the past and have rarely had the opportunity to view other art classrooms and learn from other professionals in my field - I focused on looking at classroom management and relationship building in the spaces. After each observation we discussed what we had seen, what was successful and what would be appropriate to incorporate into my space. We also discussed the makeup of the classrooms comparing it to the demographic of my classroom. [elementary art specialist]
- XXX and I have been in consistent communication throughout the year, and that has continued into Distance Learning. Because of this, we have been able to discuss student data with each other, and take a critical look at student work completion, including through a racial lens. In this analysis we have modified some aspects of our online materials to be more accessible to our EL students. Also, through completing our data cycles for our PLC, it has been very helpful to be able to discuss the racial breakdown of our data within our mentor/mentee collaboration. [middle school EL teacher]
- The mentor mentee collaboration has helped me move toward my professional goal of engaging students in language learning and avoid the distraction and abuse of cell phone use in the classroom. During our collaborative meetings, I had meaningful conversations with my mentor about my professional goal. I would state my concerns and experiences and my mentor would listen and give feedback by asking me what I think I could do or what I think would help. In that way, the solutions would come from myself and made it easier to do. My mentor also gave me good tips and helpful feedback about my concerns about cell phone use in the classroom. [secondary ELA teacher]

### Mentor Collaboration:

- I felt that we have developed a strong collaborative relationship that will continue through the years, as we continue to collaborate with one another and with others. We have learned together as we have gone along, and I feel that mutual learning experience has been very beneficial. We both could not overstate the value of the observations! We both learned so much by going to see other teachers in their teaching environments, asking questions, and discussing the visits. I also felt it was valuable to be able to discuss the importance of language objectives in lesson planning, to keep that at the forefront of our work. This has been a strong collaboration, and I look forward to continuing our relationship in the future. [elementary teacher]
- The most beneficial part of our mentoring partnership was being able to have lengthy conversations about pedagogy, racial equity and about our kids. Many of our students had significant challenges this year which, of course, impacted their learning and habits at school. It was extremely valuable to talk through those challenges with XXX -- to hear his perspective as a new teacher and as a Hmong male. [middle school EL teacher]
- Mentoring XXX has been an incredible experience for me. Because he is a creative thinker, extremely motivated, and strong-willed, our conversations were never about him doing whatever I asked him to, but rather, a dialogue about our beliefs, expectations, and understandings, and how that can help our teaching practices. As a first year teacher, he countered his lack of experience through extreme preparation and relationship focus; two incredibly strong characteristics that can't really be taught. I am a better teacher because of mentoring XXX this year. [middle school math teacher]
- XXX and I spent our mentoring sessions together working on her goals as a new educator. Her goals have focused on organization, equity for all students and accountability. During our weekly meetings we look at due process timelines, organization of her classes/lessons and student accountability. Distance Learning planning and organization has been one of our focus areas since March as well. XXX and I have talked about ways to reach families and students through this new way of teaching/learning. We have problem solved specific situations where students needed more support and/or access to the appropriate technology so they can have opportunities for school success through a DL model. [secondary SPED teacher]

The SPPS Department of Research, Evaluation, and Assessment assisted with administering and organizing survey results. The Mentor Mentee Program survey invited mentees and

mentors to share feedback on their experiences in a confidential manner. The survey collected responses between April 14th and May 7th. There was a response rate of 58% of mentors and 56% of mentees. The Mentor Mentee Survey has been in effect for over six years and is used for continuous improvement of the program. Highlights from the 2020 survey include:

- 100% of responding mentors reported that they agreed or tended to agree that they understood the expectations of being a mentor
- 97% of mentees shared that they felt encouraged and supported by their mentor
- 92% of mentees stated that their mentor usually answered their questions
- 89% of mentees who responded and 96% of mentors agreed that the Mentor Mentee Program helped them reflect on professional practices
- 87% of mentees who responded and 85% of mentors reported that they agree or tend to agree that their professional practices changed because of the Mentor Mentee Program

#### Retention Strategies

SPPS and Saint Paul Federation of Educators (SPFE) have negotiated in the current bargaining contract the language below to address additional retention strategies or protection from unrequested leave of absence for teachers who are of color or who are American Indian in their Beginning years of employment:

“The District will continue current practice in recruitment and retention of teachers of color. In addition, the District will allocate \$20,000 per contract year for the purpose of providing support and development of members of color in School and Community Service Professional, Educational Assistant and Teacher Affinity Groups. A committee comprised of equal members of the District and members of all bargaining units of the Federation will begin discussion upon ratification of the 2017-2019 contract and determine how the allocated money shall be used.”

Teacher mentorship and retention is a funding priority in Saint Paul Public Schools. In addition to these state funds, Federal ESEA funds were used directly for this project.

Unrelated to this specific project, but also supporting this type of work, SPPS has a teacher residency program supported with Federal Teacher Quality Partnership grant, State Grow Your Own Grants, a grant from the National Center for Teacher Residencies. The program focuses on recruiting persons of color with a bachelors degree to receive an elementary education or special education license to teach.

Saint Paul Public Schools participates in the MNITTP program in partnership with Augsburg College, however these funds go directly to the college and students who are in training.
