This letter serves as notification required by Laws 2017 1st Special Session, Chapter 4, Article 2, Section 16. This is the new requirement outlined in Minn. Stat. §15.0395 requiring all state agencies to report annually on intraagency transfers and interagency agreements with a value in excess of \$100,000. As legislative leaders with jurisdiction over Health and Human Services policy and finance, you are aware that the Department of Human Services has a longstanding history of reporting on transfers and interagency agreements in the form of quarterly reporting, as set forth in Minn. Stat. §256.01, Subdivision 41 and Session Law - most recently, Laws 2017 1st Special Session, Chapter 6, Article 18, Sec. 16.

A note regarding transfers reporting: DHS has historically reported on direct appropriation transfers. This would exclude technical transfers within statutory or dedicated revenue accounts. These technical transfers are primarily attributable to accounting for federal funds centrally, to align Federal Financial Participation (FFP) with program expenditures. The universe of these types of transfers is estimated to be about 200 annually. Because of their technical nature and based on pure volume, we have not included them in this report. If you would like additional information about these transfers, please contact me.

Attached to this memo please find copies of the four quarterly transfer reports and four interagency agreement reports submitted in Fiscal Year 2018. We believe this meets the terms of new reporting requirement.

Minn. Stat. §15.0395 also requires the Department to submit copies of all interagency agreements subject to the reporting requirements. The Department has previously provided you with copies of all of these agreements as part of the quarterly reporting requirements under Minn. Stat. §256.01, Subdivision 41, so we have not included the copies again with this report. We will provide additional copies of any agreements upon request.
